To Divide the parishes aforesaid and That the Inhabitants
of the said Prince George parish shall have and
Enjoy all benefites and Priviledges power and Authority
In every respect Equall with any Inhabitants of any
Other parish within this province heretofore had or here
after may have and further Giving to the severall freeholders
of Prince Georges parish aforesaid at a certaine
Day to be appointed by them full and ample power -
To Elect and make choice of the number of six Elect
Vestry men at least and Two Church wardens and also
To Build and found a Church Therein any law Statute
usage or custom to the contrary notwithstanding
And be it further Enacted by the authority aforesaid
That it shall and may be Lawfull for the Justices
of Prince Georges County upon application to them
made by the vestry of Prince George parish aforesaid
To cause to be Levyed in such manner as the publick
and County levies are Levyed upon the Taxable persons
in the said parish so much Tobacco as will enable
The said parish to Build a church so that the said
sum so to be Levyed for that end do not exceed the sum
of Twenty Thousand pounds of Tobacco any law
Statute usage or custom to the contrary Thereof
