Samrd An Act making Good and Effectuall in Law and
of Bargain and Sale from the Rent of Charles County
to Thomas Collier of the same County - - - - -
when Recited

Whereas Thomas Collier of Charles County by his
humble petition to this General Assembly hath set forth
That in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hun-
dred and nine he purchased from a certain Thomas
Dent of the same County a Tract of Land called Wheelers
Palme or by the Deed thereof appears which Deed
the said Osburne had Duly acknowledged before two
Justices at the then next County Court and paid the
Alienation as usual in such cases and Delivered
the same to John Rogers Gentl^r Clerk of Charles
County Court aforesaid but whether on his the said
Petitioners Request or by what other means Occa-
sioned the said Petitioner cannot charge his Memory
The Deed aforesaid was put into his possession
against the same Day he Comitted by the said Clerk
To be recorded as an Enquiry is since found and the
Thomas Dent the vendor of the aforesaid Tract of
Land hath Declared his Willingness to make the said
Osburne a new Deed yet apprehendeth it might
Render him Obnoxious and liable to be sued &
prosecuted by his creditors unless he received the value
against Distribute among them according to an Act
late made for his Relief which yet he thinks most
unjust in as much as he has been Once fully satis-
fied and paid for the same to Collier which the just
hath prayed that leave may be given him to bring in
a bill to Supply the Defect aforesaid all which this
Assembly have taken into their serious Consideration
