lawfull for the said Thomas Osburn att any time  
within six months after the end of this session of  
Assembly to Enrol or cause to be entered on the records  
of Charleroy County the Deed of Sale of the Tract of  
Land called Wheeler's Bottom aforesaid pur-  
chased from the aforesaid Thomas Dent and when  
so enrolled the said Thomas Osburn and his heirs  
and assigns for ever shall by virtue thereof and of  
this act be invested with the same Estate right title  
Interest property claim and Demand of in and to  
the said Tract of Land called Wheeler's Bottom and —  
shall have hold occupy posse and enjoy all and  
singular the rights members advantages and —  
appurtenances to the same belonging and in any-  
wise appertaining in a full and ample manner to  
all Intents Constructions and purposes in the Law  
whatsoever as if the said Deed had been recorded  
within six months from the Date and acknowledgment  
of the said Deed any Law Statute Usage or Custom  
to the contrary in any wise notwithstanding
