Made in the prerogative Court for Probate of wills within
 this province Be it enacted by the right Honourable
 The Lord Proprietary by and with the advice and
 consent of his Lordships Governour and the upper
 and lower Houses of Assembly and the authority of
 the same That Every person against whom any Sen-
 tence or Decree hath been made in the said Court since
 the first Day of May this present year shall and
 may by Virtue of this Act be at Liberty to enter an
 appeal from any such Sentence or Decree at any
 Time within Thirty Days after the End of this
 present Session of Assembly and the said appeal
 to prosecute before a Court of Delegates at any
 Time within Thirty Days after such appeal is
 entered and That all persons against whom any
 Sentence or Decree in the said prerogative Court
 shall hereafter be made shall be allowed the space
 of Thirty Days to enter an appeal there from and
 Thirty Days more to prosecute such before a Court
 of Delegates any thing in the Act for the better
 Administration of Justice in Testamentary
 Affairs Granting Administrations &c or any
 other Law Statute Usage or Custom to the contrary
 thereof notwithstanding ~ ~ ~ ~ ~
