Brannock was liable to answer and Satisfy to him the said Thomas Machamara, together with Interest on the said Costs and Expences amounting to the aforesaid quantity of Eleven hundred and twelve Pounds of Tobacco whereas in truth no such quantity of Tobacco for such additional or other Costs and Expences were due to the same Thomas Machamara, to the great damage of the said John Brannock, and the Contempt of the Laws of this Province and the said Lord Proprietary, his good Rule and Dignity.

HE Humble Representation of some of the Justices of the Provincial Court. Humbly Sheweth That Mr. Macnamara, a Practitioner of the Law in the Provincial and other Courts in this Province, is a Person of such a Turbulent, Refractory, Haughty and Abusive Temper, that it hath been his common Practice (when his Circumstances would by any means Support him) to Despite, Affront and Contemn the Authority of the Justices of fuch Courts, especially that of the Provinical, for which he bath been heretosoie Suspended.
