An ACT reviving and continuing an Act, Intituled, An Act to restrain the ill Practices of Attorneys, and to prevent their taking Money Fees, and ascertaining what Fees shall be allowed to the Practitioners in the Law, who shall attend the Circuit Courts; made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis, the Fisteenth Day of March, Anno Domini One Thousand Seven Hundred and Twenty Five.

BE IT ENACTED, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of His Lordship's Governour, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That the Act, Intituled, An Act to restrain the ill Practices of Attorneys; and to prevent their taking Money Fees, and ascertaing what Fees shall be allowed to the Practitioners in the Law, who shall attend the Circuit Courts; made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis, the Fisteenth Day of March, in the Year of Our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Twenty Five, be, and is hereby revived and continued to be and remain in full Force, Power, and Virtue.

This Act to continue for Three Years, and to the End of the next Seffion of Assembly that shall happen after the End of the said Three Years.

## An ACT for the Relief of Thomas Worsley, Hezekiah Clark, and Benjamin Freeman, Prisoners in Anne-Arundel County Goal.

HEREAS the faid Thomas Worsley, Hezekiah Clark, and Benjamin Freeman, have represented to this General Assembly, that they have a long Time lain in Goal, and that they have not wherewithal to satisfy their Creditors; but that they may be capable, having Time given them, to satisfy their several Creditors,

BE IT THERE FORE EN ACTED, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of His
Lordship's Governour, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and
the Authority of the same, That Mr. James Govane, Sheriff of AnneArundel County, do let the said Thomas Worsley at Large, immediately
after the End of this Session of Assembly, he satisfying Mr. Richard
Snowden a Debt recovered against him, in Anne-Arundel County Court,
as he by his Petition has proposed, with Cost; and giving the said Govane
his own Bills of Exchange, or Bond, at the Rate of Ten Shillings Sterling
per Hundred, for Fees due to the said Govane.

AND BE IT FURTHER E NACTED, by the Authority, Advice and Consent aforesaid, That the said Hezekiah Clark, and Benjamin Freeman, be released from their Imprisonment, and be free from any Arrest or Execution either against Body or Goods, for Debt or Dama-
