An ACT for the Assessment of Sixty Thousand Pounds of Tobacco on the Invalue Inhabitants of Durham Parish, in Charles County, for the building a Church.

HEREAS, the Vestrymen, and several other Inhabitants of Durham Parith, in Grarles Councy, by their Petition to this General Assembly, have set forth, That their Parith Church is so decayed, that it is impracticable to repair it; and have prayed, that an Act may pass, that so much Tobacco may be levied on the Taxable Persons of the said Parish, to be paid, by equal Proportions, at Three several Times, to enable them to build the said Church,

BE it therefore Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Conjent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Froujes of Assembly, and the Authority of the Jame, That the Justices of Charles County Court, thall and may, and they are hereby authorized and directed, on the Application of the Vestrymen and Churchwardens of the faid Parish, to assets and levy on the Taxable Inhabitants of the faid Parish, the Quantity of Sixty Thousand Pounds of Tobacco for the Ules aforelaid; but that not above the Quantity of Twenty Thousand Pounds of Tobaccoobe levied in any One Year; which said Tobacco to be levied, n all be collected by the Sheriff of Charles County, for the Time being, who is hereby authorized and directed to collect the same, and who shall have, for such Collection, at and after the Rate of Five per Cent. And the faid Tobacco, when so collected, shall be paid Year'y to the Vestr men and Churchwardens, who are hereby authorized and required to apply the same to the building and finishing a new Church in the faid Parish.

An ACT for the Affinent of so much Tobacco on the Inhabitants of St. Pau's Parish, in Prince-George's County, as will build them a new Parish Church and Chafel of Laje.

W HFRFAS, the Vestrymen, Churchwardens, and other the Inhabitants of St. Paul's Parish, in Prince-Ceorge's County, have, by their Petition to this General Assembly, let forth, That their Parish Church and Chapel of Ease, are so extreamly out of Repair, that there is an absolute Necessity for building new Ones; and have prayed, that an Act may pass, that so much Tobacco may be levied on the Taxable Persons of the said Parish, as will enable them to build first a new Church, and afterwards a Chapel, in such Place in the said Parish, as shall be thought most convenient by the Majority of the Parishioners,

BE it therefore Enasted, by the Right Honourable the I ord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That the Justices of Prince-George's County, shall and may, and they are hereby authorized and directed, on the Application of the Vestrymen and Churchwardens of the said Parish, to assess and levy on the Vestrymen of the said Parish, any Quantity of Tobacco, not exceeding Twenty Thousand Pounds of Tobacco in any One Year, and to continue
