A Supplementary ACT to the Act, intituled, An Act for erecting a Town in Kent County, on the South Side of Sassafras River, on a Tract of Land, called, Tolechester, at the Place where the Ferry is now kept.

WHEREAS, by the said recited Ast, certain Persons were appointed Commission rs for buying Sixty Acres of Land, out of the above-mentioned Tract, called, Tolechester, and to crest the same into a Town, by the Name of George Town; and for causing the same to be surveyed, and divided into One Hundred equal Lots, some Time-before the Last Day of December last: And whereas, it appears to this present General Assembly, that to do and personn the several Requisites therein mentioned; by Means whereof, the said Act is altogether rendered inessectual. For Remedy whereof, it prayed, that it may be Enacted,

AND BEITENACTED, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, hy and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Gover-top, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That the several Commissioners nominated and appointed by the said recited Act, or the major Part of them, are, by this Act, impowered to do the several Matters and Things every Way relating thereto, in as still and ample Manner, as they might or could have done, at any Time before the by the Last Day of October, which shall be in the Year of Our Lord, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Thirty Seven; any thing in the said recited Act to the contrary, notwithstanding.

A Supplementary ACT to the Act for erecting a Town at Joppa, in Baltimore County.

WHEREAS, by the said Act, it is provided, That if any Taker up of a Lot or Lots in said Town, shall not build upon said Lot or Lots, according to the Directions of the said Act, that then, any other Person might take up the said Lots not built upon, as aforesaid; which said Second Taker-up should pay the Value of such Lot so taken up, to the Commissioners, or the major Part of them, or such other Person as the said Commissioners should a point, to be laid out and applied for the Use and Benefit of said Town. And whereas, it appears to this present Assembly, That there is now a Sum of Money in the Hands of the Clerk of said Town, appointed by said Commissioners to receive the same, unapplied or laid out for Use of the said Town; and the Commissioners, or the major Part of them, being dead, the said Money cannot be applied, as directed in said Act:

BE IT THERE FORE ENACTED, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Conjent of His Lord-flip's Covernor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Justices of Baltimore County, or the major Patt of them, be and are hereby authorized and impowered to take and re-
