An ACT for Reviving an Act of Assembly of this Province, entituled, Lin List ascertaining the Gauge and Tare of Tobacco Hogsheads, and to prevent cutting, cropping and defating Tobacco taken on board Ships or Vessels upon Freight.

E it Enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That the abovementioned Act, entituled, An Act estertaining the Gauge and Tare of Tohacco Hogsheads, and to prevent dutting, eropping and defacing Tohacco taken on board Ships or Vessels upon Freight, made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis, the Twentieth Day of April, Anno Domini, Seven-Reviving an teen Hundred and Thirty Six, be, and is hereby Revived and Continued Act. to be and remain in full Force, for and during the Term of Three Years next ensuing, and unto the end of the next Session of Assembly that shall happen after the end of the said Three Years.

An ACT for the Benefit of the Poor and Encouragement of Industry.

HEREAS several Inhabitants of this Province, especially the Preamble. poorer fort, cannot provide necessary Cloathing, particularly Linen, for themselves and their Families, by their produce of their Crops of Tobacco in the present low state of that Commodity, and that making Linen Cloth of Flax and Hemp of the Growth of the Country, would be of great Advantage to the People thereof in general, and therefore, and to the end that so useful and beneficial a Work may be Encouraged, It is prayed that it may be Enacted,

And be it Enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That at the next November County Courts within this Province, and at 30 Pounds to every November Court during the continuance of this Act, the Justices each county of each respective County Court, shall levy on the Taxable Inhabitants of fortie the each respective County, the Sum of Thirty Pounds Current Money of couragement of making Maryland, in the same manner as other County Changes are levied, to—Linen Cloth. gether with the Sheriss's Salary, to be applied to the Uses and Purposes sollowing, (That is to say) Six Pounds to be paid to the Person who shall bring to August Court which shall be in the Year Seventeen Hundred and Forty One, and to every August Court afterwards, during the continuance of this Act, the best Piece of Linen Cloth of Twenty Yards at least in length, and one Yard wide at least, The Sum of Fave Pounds, to such Person
