An Act continuing an Act entituled, A Supplementary Act to an Act entituled, An Act laying an Imposition on Negroes and several Sorts of Liquors imported; and also on Irish Servants, to prevent the Importing too great a Number of Irish Papills into this Province.

B it Enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by An A& conand with the Advice and Confent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That the abovementioned Act entituled, A Supplementary Act to an Act entituled, An Act laying an Imposition on Negroes and several Sorts of Liquors imported; and also on Irish Servants, to prevent the Importing too great a Number of Lish Papists into this Province, made at a Session of Ass. mbly begun and held at the City of Annapolis, the Twentieth Day of March, Anno Domini One Thousand Seven Hundred and Thirty-four, be, and is hereby continued, and shall be in full Force for and during the Term of Three Years next ensuing, and to the End of the next Session of Assembly which shall happen after the End of the said Three Years.

An Act impowering the Justices of Prince George's County, to levy on the taxable Inhabitants of Queen sanne's Parish in the faid County, the Sum of Two Hundred Pounds Current Money, for the Uses therein mentioned.

HEREAS, the Vestry-men of Queen Anne's Parish in Prince Preamble. George's County, have by their humble Petition to this General Assembly set sorth, that their Parish Church and Chapel want fundry Repairs, and that the said Chapel is too small to accommodate their Parishioners in a decent Manner, and that it was thought necessary to enlarge it; and have humbly prayed that an A& may pals, that Two Hundred Pounds Current Money may be levied upon the taxable Persons of the said Parish, for those Purposes, by Two equal Assessments.

Be it therefore Enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of bitants of Q. the same, That the Justices of Prince George's County, shall and may, and they are hereby authorized and empowered, on the Application of County, for the faid Vestry-men and Church-Wardens, to affels and levy upon the repairing and taxable Inhabitants of the faid Parish the aforesaid Two Hundred Pounds, Church and at Two equal Assessments; which said Sum of Two Hundred Pounds Chapel. shall be collected by the Sheriff of the said County, who is hereby authorized and directed to collect the same, and who shall have for such Collection, at and after the Rate of Five Pounds per Centum: and the faid Money, when so collected, shall be paid to the said Vestry and Church-Wardens,
