THEREAS, the said Francis O Connor, Robert Noble, Jo-Seph Richardson, Thomas Joy, Cornelius Mahany, and Robert Floyd, by their humble Petition to this present General Aslembly, have let forth, that they have continued Prisoners for Debt in the Custody of the Sheriffs of the several Counties aforesaid, and still continue in the like deplorable Circumstances, and not being able to redeem their Bodies with all the Estate or Interest that they have in the World, which they would readily deliver up and part ith to their feveral and respective Creditors, if they would accept the same and grant the said Petitioners their Liberty, which seems so unlikely for them to obtain, that unless relieved by a particular Act Passed in their Favours, which by their laid Petition they have humbly prayed, they must ine-And for that the Truth of the said vitably continue Priloners for Life. Petitioners Allegations are made appear to this present General Assembly by lufficient Testimony, and that the said Petitioners are fit Objects of Charity, and that their lying in Goal can be no Benefit to their Creditors, it is humbly Prayed that the faid Petitioners may be Relieved according to their Pravers, and that it may be Enacted;

Creditors to go to the Sheriffe in 20 Days, and give fourity for Fees, 2000

And be it Enasted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Confent of his Lordship's Governor, and pper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the Jan. That unless all or any of the Creditor or Creditors of any of the said Pritoners, or the Attorney of such Creditors aforesaid within this Provinc., shall, within Twenty Days after the End of this Session of Asfem Iv, go to the Sheriffs of the aforefaid Counties of Dorchester, Talbot, Cacil, and Queen-Anne's and give good Security to pay the Imprisonment Fees the Sum of Ten Pounds of Tobacco per Day, that shall. or may hecome due from the said Prisoners respectively, after the end of the I id Twenty Days, and also find the said Prisoners, sufficient Meat, Drink and Cloathing, during their future Imprisonment; and in case they the laid Priton is shall deliver up and surrender, or cause to be delivered up and furrendered, to the Sheriffs of the Counties aforesaid, in the Prefince of Two Justices of the Peace of the said Counties, whom the Jaid Sheriffs are hereby required to Summon, on the request of the said Priloners, at lome convenient Time after the receipt of this Ady not ex-
