and Prices aforefaid, directly or indirectly take, exact, demand, or i ceive, for the Price and Pay for any fuch Liquois or other Accommo tions, for which the Rates and Prices thall be to affeffed, from any P son or Persons whatsoever, above the Rates and Prices so assessed, she for every such Account charged; sued for, taken, or received, forfeit a pay the Sum of fifty Shillings current Money, to be collected, paid applied as aforesaid; and in case of Suit on such Account, such Ordinal keeper shall be Nonsuit, and pay the Defendant his full Cost of Su And for every fuch Account paid and fatisfied to any Ordinary-keep such Ordinary-keeper shall, on Complaint of such Matter by the Par injured, to a single Magistrate or County Court, be by such Magistrate Court, in a summary Way, ordered and compelled to restore to such P ty injured the whole Sum so before had and received on such Account and his Cost on such Complaint; the said Forseiture to be recovered his Lordship's Name, before any Magistrate of the County where Offence shill be committed, as in case of small Debts.

And be it Enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That the Party gried ed shall be deemed a legal Witness (being under no Incapacity of being Witness in other Cases), to prove any Exaction or Extortion contrary this Act.

And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That eve Ordinary-k :eper or Inn-holder to to be licensed as aforetaid, shall with six Months after granting their respective Licenses, be hereby obliged provide and maintain, if they keep Ordinary at the Court-houf in an County, four good and substantial Beds; or at the City of Annapolis forelaid, fix good Bids; over and above what is for their own Family Ule, with sufficient warm Covering for the same, and Indian Corn, O. Hay, Straw, and Stabling for ten Horses at least: And if any Oction be kept at any other Place or Part of the County than at the County house, such Ordinary-keeper shall within the Time aforesaid be provide with three Ipue Beds, with Covering, and sufficient Stabling and Prove der for six Hories at least; under the Penalty of ten Pounds current Me ney, one halt thereof to the Commissioners or Trustees aforesaid, to collected by the Sheriffs of the respective Counties where the faid Offen shall be committed, and by the said Sheriffs paid to the said Commission ers, to be applied as aforesaid; the other half to him or them that sh inform or sue ser the same; to be recovered by Action of Debt, B Plaint, or Information, in the Names of the Lord Proprietary and Inf mer; wherein no Essoin, Piotection, or Wager of Law, to be allow Previded always, That no Person or Persons so licented, or to be license to keep Ordinary as aforesaid, shall, during the Time of such their kee ing Ordinary, be Delegates, Justices of Peace, Attorneys, Depu Commissaries, Clerks, Sheriffs, Deputy Sheriffs, or Jury-men; or hos any other public Office within this Province.

And be it further Enacted, That if sny Ordinary-keeper shall keep vil Rule in his House, upon Complaint made thereof to the Justices
