Or if there be no Ship to receive the said Tobacco, then it shall and may be law ful for the Master of the first mentioned Ship or Vessel, to put the said Tobacco into the nearest Warehouse to the Place where such Ship shall ride, giving immediate Notice thereof to the Inspectors who stamped the same. And the Inspectors of that Warehouse where such Tobacco shall be delivered, shall give a Receipt for the same, and shall cause the said Tobacco to be tasely lodged, and delivered to the Order of the Owner thereof, whenever he or she shall think sit to ship it off; and that without Fee or Reward.

And be it further Enasted, That every Master of a Ship or Vessel, wherein Tobacco shall be laden, shall, at the Time of Cleaning, deliver to the Naval Officer three fair Manifests of all the Tobacco on board his Ship or Vessel, expressing the Marks and Numbers of every Hogshead, and the Tare and nett Weight, stamped thereon, the Perton by whom shipped, and from what Warehouse, and shall make Oath, or Affirmation it a Quaker, thereto, and that the same is a just and true Account of the Marks, Numbers, Tare, and nett Weight of each respective Hogshead, as the same was taken down by the Person or Persons appointed by him to take the same, before the said Tobacco was stowed away. And no Ship or Vessel shall be cleared by the Naval Officer, before he shall have received such Lists and Manitests; one of which said Manifests shall, by the said Naval Officer, be annexed to such Master's Certificate or Clearance, to the End the same may be delivered to the chi f Officer of the Customs, in such Port or Place where the said Ship shall unlade; and the other two of the said Manisests shall, by the said Naval Officer, be transmitted to the said chief Officer of the Customs, by the two next convenient Opportunities.
