And be it further Enacted, That the Vestry-men and Church-wardens of Queen Caroline Parish in Anne-Arundel County, have full Power and Authority to elect and recommend four Inspectors for a Warehouse appointed to be at Elk-Ridge Landing, situate and being in St. Margaret's Westminster Parish, and to proceed as if the faid Warehouse had by this Act been appointed to be in Queen Caroline Patish; and that the Vestry-men and Church-wardens of St. Margaret's Westminster Parish, no way intermeddle with the Election or Recommendation of Intectors for the faid Warehouse to be at Elk-Ridge Landing: And that the faid Inspectors and Inspection be under the same regulation as if nominated and recommended by the Veltry-men and Church-wardens of St Margaret's Westminster Parish; any thing in this Act contained to the contrary notwithftanding.

And be it further Enasted, That it shall and may be lawful for the Inhabi- Indulgence to tants of Annapolis, or luch of them as shall think fit, at their own proper Cest theinbait ...ts and Charge, to Rent or Build a Warchouse, and to provide all other Conveniencies for the Inspection and Prizing Tobacco; and for the Vestry-men and Chu chwardens of Saint Anne's Parith to nominate and recommend four sufficient and capable Planters to be Inspectors, out of which four Persons two shall be Appointed by the Governor or Commander in Chief, as in other cates; and that the faid Inhabitants, or such of them as shall Erect or Rent such Warehouse, shall pay such Inspectors such Silary as they and the Inspectors si all agree upon.

And be it Enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That all Tobacco that shall Inspectors, be brought to any of the public Warchoules herein before-mentioned, shall be Viewed, Examined, and Inspected, by two Persons to be thereunto appointed, who shall be called Inspectors, and nominated and appointed in Manner and Form following, That is to lay, The leveral and respective Vestry-men and Church-wardens of every Parith within this Province wherein any Warehoule shall be erected or established in virtue of this Act, or the major Part of them, shall and may, and they are hereby authorized and required, to meet together at their several and respective Parish Churches, on the first Week of December, Seventeen Hundred an I forty-eight, and on the first Week of December, yearly, and every year, during the continuance of this Act, and to nominate and recommend to the Governor or Commander in Chief of this Province for the Time being, four able and sufficient Planters, well skilled in Tobacco, for each and every Inspection within their different Parishes, for the Execution of the Office of If two Ware-Inspectors: And where it shall happen that two Warehouses, under one and the houses, under same Inspection, shall be in different Parishes, the Vestry-men and Church-Wardens of each Parish, or the major part of them, shall nominate and re- Parishes, then commend two able and fufficient Persons, well skilled in Tobacco, for such Inipection.

And be it Enasted, That the several and respective Vestry-men and Church- Listo berewardens, in both thele Cales, thall forthwith grantmit Certificates of such Nomination and Recommendation, to the Clerk of the Council for the Time being, to be by him immediately laid before the Governor or Commander in Chief for the Time being; out of which faid four Perfons in the first Case to be nominated and recommended for Inspectors, the Governor or Commander in Chief shall and may choose and app int two Persons by Warrant under his Hand, out of the four recommended to him from any one Vestry and Church-wardens, to be Inspectors; and in the latter Case, that is, where it shall happen that two Warehouses under one and the same Inspection, shall be in different Parishes, there the Governor, or Commander in Chief for the Time being, shall and may choole and appoint two Perfons to be Inspectors, in manner aforelaid, to wit, one out of the Nomination and Recommendation of each Parish, to execute the Office of Inspectors at such Inspection.
