

pleat the Buildings aforesaid, and other Conveniences, which the said Justices shall find requisite for the Uses of such Inspecting House or Houses. *Provided always,* That the Justices of any one County shall not take out of the said Loan-Office a Sum exceeding one hundred Pounds Current Money, for any one House, and the other Necessaries thereto belonging.

*And be it Enacted,* That where the Justices aforesaid shall cause to be built and made the said Warehouses, Wharffs, and other Conveniences, that they paying or tendering the Value of the Land, so as aforesaid set, to the Proprietor or Proprietors, the Guardian, Husband, or Attorney, as aforesaid, as the Case shall be, that then such Justices shall have an absolute Estate in Fee Simple, to them and their Successors, in said Land, to the Use of the County: And where the said Buildings and other Conveniences shall be made and found by the Justices as aforesaid, the several Inspectors shall pay the Sum of twelve Pence Current Money, for every Hoghead in this Act mentioned so as aforesaid, by him or them taken in and delivered out, to the said Justices; and the said Justices shall, with all convenient Speed, pay the same to the said Commissioners or Trustees of the Loan-Office, at the City of *Annapolis*; and shall moreover pay to the said Commissioners or Trustees, for the Time being, all Moneys that shall otherwise be raised from such Warehouse or Warehouses, over and above the Salaries to Inspectors, Rents of Warehouses, and other incident Charges, until such Time as the whole of the principal Money taken out of the said Loan-Office shall be refunded and paid in: And that afterwards the Money that shall be raised for Rent, or otherwise; that is to say, so much thereof as shall not be applied to defray the Expence of said Warehouse or Warehouses, shall be paid by the several and respective Inspectors to the several and respective Justices, and by the said Justices applied to defray the Charge of their respective Counties.

*And be it further Enacted,* That where any Money shall be taken out of the Loan-Office, by the Justices of any County Court within this Province, for purchasing Land, building any of the Warehouses, and supplying the same with Necessaries, according to the Directions of this Act; and that the Rent, Profit, or Income of such Warehouse or Houses shall not be sufficient to refund and replace the Money so taken out, that in every such Case, the Deficiency shall be satisfied by and out of the public Levy, or Stock, of this Province, and not otherwise.

*And be it further Enacted,* That there shall be kept at every one of the said Warehouses a good and sufficient Beam, Weights, and Scales, to weigh twelve hundred gross Pounds at the least; and a Set of small Weights, the same that are or ought to be provided for the Standard Weights of each County: And the said Justices are hereby required and obliged to purchase the same for each Warehouse; as also Blocks, Tackles, and other Necessaries, out of the Money to be taken out of the Loan-Office as aforesaid; and an Account of the Charges thereof to transmit to the Commissioners or Trustees thereof.

*And it is further Enacted,* That the Commissioners or Trustees for emitting Bills of Credit shall, and they are hereby obliged to pay to the Justices of the several and respective Counties within this Province, such Sum and Sums as they shall respectively require according to the Direction of this Act: And the said Trustees are hereby obliged and directed to keep distinct Accounts with each respective County, charging therein the Sums paid, and to what Justices, and of what County; and when and as often as any Payments shall be made by any of the Counties, such their Accounts shall be credited with such Payment. *And moreover,* The said Justices are hereby directed and required, once in every Year at the least, to appoint two or more of their Number to view the said Scales, and examine and try the Weights at the several Warehouses by the Standard Weights of the County; and if the same, or the other Necessaries hereby required, shall want repairing, or the Weights be found deficient or differing from the lawful Standard, the said Justices shall cause the same to be repaired and amended, and the Weights made conformable to the Standard, and the Charge of repairing and amending as aforesaid shall be paid by the Inspectors respectively, and be again allowed them in their Account with the said Justices.

*And*

Justices paying for Land, to be invested with an Estate in Fee Simple, &c.

Deficiency in repaying the Money taken out of the Loan Office, to be supplied out of the public Stock.

Beams, Weights, and Scales, to be kept at each Warehouse.

Commissioners of the Paper-Office to pay the Justices such Sums as shall be required.
