and Mad besit further Enatted, That, in case the Proprietor or Quiner, Guardian, Husband, or Attorney, as atoresaid, shall undertake the Building as aforesaid, and keeping the same in Repair; or in case he, she, or they, will not, and that the lame he done by any other Perlon as aforelaid; that in either of these Cales the Builder or Builders shall be, and are hereby obliged to let the same to the Inspector or Inspectors of such Warehouse, under the Penalty of two hundred Rounds Current Money of this Province, at the Rates following; (that is to lay.) The Inspector or Inspectors of said Warehouse shall, and are hereby obliged to pay to the Party building as aforefaid, twelve Pence for every Hogshead of Tobasco that shall be received into such Warehouse, and delivered out of the same inspected, and that annually.

and foralmuch as that at tome of the Places before mentioned for Warehouses Of Warehouse to be built, there may happen to be a Warehouse or Warehouses already built for the Conveniency of private People, Be it Enacted, That in any luch Case, if the Proprietor or Owner will let luch House or Houses to the Inspector or Inspectors to be appointed, for a Warehouse at such Place, that then, and in such Gale, the Proprietor or Owner of fuch House or Houses, building a Wharst, and giving Security to keep such House or Houses and Wharff in Repair, and making any Addition to laid Building that shall be thought necessary and convenient by the Justices as aforelaid, shall be paid the Rent aforesaid in Manner a-

And to prevent any Mistakes in the carrying this Act into Execution by the Justices as aforelaid, or any Prejudice that may arile, either to the Commissioners or Trustees for emitting Bills of Credit, established by Act of Assembly, or to any of the Counties within this Province; It is hereby Declared and Enact. ed; That all such Moneys as shall be taken out of the laid Loan Office for the Uses of this Act, shall be paid in again out of the Profits of the respective Warehouses, and according to the Directions of this Act, until the faid Office shall be be provided. paid the Principal Money to given out to the respective Justices as aforesaid: And that where the Warehouse or Warehouses, Wharsfis, Prizes, and Cranes are built and provided by any other Perlon in this Act mentioned, then the Rent of twelve Pence per Hogshead as aforetaid shall be paid to tuch Person or Persons so building and providing as aforesaid by the several Inspectors; and the Residue of the seven Shillings per Hogshead, and sour Shillings per Hogshead, mentioned in this Act, shall be applied to pay and defray the Charge of the Inspectors Sallaries, and other Expences, such as finding Weights and Scales, and other Necessaries mentioned in this Act, and the keeping them in Repair according to the true Intent and Meaning of this Act. And that for all Matters relating to the Expence of putting this Act in Execution, and the Profits to be railed thereby, the several Inspectors shall annually lay before the respective Justices fair and distinct Accounts of the Profits and Lois relating to their respective Offices on Oath, or Affirmation if a Quaker; and the Justices aforelaid shall settle and adjust such Accounts; and that if the Profits of laid Warehouses shall over and above bear the Expences of this Act, that then the overplus Money shall be applied to defray the Charge of the County.

And be it further Enasted, That where any Warchouses shall be built by the Justices, or other Persons not Proprietors, and shall hereafter happen to be discontinued for fifteen Months, the Proprietor of the Land returning the Price paid for the faid Land, shall be from thenceforth seized of his former Estate.

Provided always, That nothing herein contained shall be construed to give Proviso. Power to the taid Justices to take away the Houses, Orchards, or other immediate Conveniences of any Proprietor of Land, for the Ules or Purposes aforesaid; nor to the said Inspectors to keep any Hosses, Cattle, or Hogs, at any the public Warehouses (except in Inclosures), upon the Land appointed for such Warehouses; and if any Swine belonging to the said Inspectors, or any of them, shall be found at large upon the Land appropriated for such Warehouses, or the Lands adjoining thereto, it shall and may be lawful for the Proprietor of the Land, on which the said Warehouses are to be placed, to kill, or cause them to be killed or destroyed. And the said Justices, in their respective Counties, shall,
