other Person whatsoever, unless such Swine or Geese be kept within such Perton or Person's own Inclosure to keeping or supporting such Swine or Geete, under the Penalty of Ten Shillings Current Money for each Transgression, to be recovered before any Magistrate, as in the case of small Debts, for the use of the faid County School.

An Act impowering the Vestry-men and Church-wardens of All Saints Parith in Prince-George's County, or of the County wherein the faid Parish shall be, to purchase Three separate Acres of Land in the faid Parith, whereon to Build a Church and two Chapels of ease; and to impower the Justices of Prince-George's County, or of the County wherein the faid Parish shall be, to levy on the Taxable Inhabitants of the faid Parish, the Sum of Three Hundred Pounds Current Money, for the uses therein mentioned.

7 HEREAS the Vestry-men and Church-wardens of All Saints Pa- Preamble. rish in Prince George's County, have, by their humble Petition to this General Assembly, set forth, That they have no Place of Worship to meet together in, for the Service of Almighty GOD, for want whereof they are very little benefited by having an established Minister, That they have agreed to Build a Parish Church at Frederick-Town on Carroll's Creek as the most six Place for the same, and Pray that the Sum of two Hundred Pounds Current Money, may be raifed and levied on the taxable Inhabitants of faid Parish, by two equal Assessments, towards Building the same: And by their said Petition, surther let forth, that the said Parish is so large, and lies so inconvenient, that a vist many of the Inhabitants thereof cannot possibly come to the Parish Church when Erected as aforesaid, and therefore pray that a further Sum of Fifty Pounds Current Money, may be also raised and levied as aforefail, and applied towards Building a Chapel already begun, standing between Monoccaly and Seneca Creek; and that the like Sum of Fifty Pounds may be also raised, levied and applied, towards erecting one other Chapel at some Place between Anti-eatum and Connogocheague; and that the faid Two Chapels may be adopted Chapels of Eafe in faid Parish for Ever: All which being by this present General Assembly, thought reasonable; It is humbly prayed that it may be Enacted,

And be it Enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That the Vestrymen and Church-wardens of All-Saints Parish, in Prince-George's County aforesaid, or the major Part of them, be, and are hereby, authorized and impowered, to agree for, and purchale, Three Acres of Land, at the most convenient Places in the laid Parish, for the erecting a Parish Church, and Two Chapels of Ease, for the use and benefit of the Parithioners aforesaid, which said Church, and Chapels of Ease so to be Built thereon, shall be, and are hereby constituted and deemed, a Church, and Chapels of Eate, of the laid Parish, and shall for ever hereaster be respectively supported and repaired at the Charge of the said Parish.

And be it further Enacted, That the Justices of Prince-George's County Court aforesaid, or of the County wherein the said Parish shall be, shall and may, 300 1 to be and they are hereby authorized and directed, on the application of the Vestrymen and Church-wardens of the aforeiaid Parish, to assess and levy by two even and equal Assessments, on the taxable Inhabitants of the same Parish, the som of Three Hundred Pounds Current Money, to be paid by the Parishioners by the Tenth Day of April yearly, which faid Affestments so to be levied, shall be collected by the Sheriff of Prince-George's County, or of the County wherein the faid Parish shall be, for the Time being, who is hereby authorized and required to collect the same, and shall have for such Collection after the rate of Five per Centum, and the said Money, when so collected, shall be paid to the Vestry-men and Church-wardens aforesaid, who are hereby authorized and required to apply the same to the uses aforesaid, in such manner as to them shall seem meet.
