Booth, or other Conveniency, on the Days on which such Yearly Meetings shall Penalty for be kept, and within a Distance not less than three Miles from such Meeting to Servants of Houles in the fam Counties of Talbot and Anne-Arundel, shall not fell, give, or Slaves. dispole of any throng or spirituous Liquor, or give any Entertainment or other Accommodations, upon any Pretence whatfoever, to any Servant, Negro, or other Slave, under Pain of losing the Price of the Liquor fo fold, given, or difposed of, and paving morcover the Sum of Twenty Shillings Current Money; to be recovered before any fingle Magistrate of the County, upon the Oath (or Affirmation it a Quaker) it any one credible Witness, and applied as aforesaid.

And be it further Enasted, That such Ordinary-Keeper shall not sell, give, No Liquors to or dispose of any Liquois, or other Accommodations, or give any Entertainment Sunfer in any in any Booth, or other Convenience, except luch as shall be at his or her dwelling Booth. Houle, to any Perion or Perions whatfoever, on any of the leveral and refpective Days on which such Meetings shall be kept and held as aforesaid, after Sunletting of the same Day, under the Pendty and Forseiture of Five Pounds Current Money for every such Offence, to be recovered and applied as aforesaid.

And be it further Enacted, That no Person or Persons whatsoever, shall here- No Horse Raafter run or pace any Race or Races with any Horse, Mare, or Gelding, for any Wager or Wagers, for Divertion, or on any Pretence what soever, on the Ground ings. commonly called New-Market, in Talbot County, or within the Distance of Five Miles from the Meeting House in the said County, or within Five Miles of the Meeting House on West River, in Anne-Arundel County, on the Days on which the said Meetings of either of them shall be kept and held, under the Penalty of the Owner or Owners of fuch Horle, Marc, or Gelding, who shall so run or pace his Horse, Maie, or Gelling, or knowingly suffer them to be run or paced, forfeiting and paying for every fuch Race Five Pounds Current Money, to be recovered and applied as aforefaid. And the Person or Persons who shall presume to make any Horse-Race, lay any Wager on such Race, or run for his or their Diversion, or who shall prejume to ride a Race on any Horse, Mare, or Gelding, belonging to any other Perion, on the Days and within the Distances from the laid respective Meeting Houses afore-mentioned, shall for every Offence, forseit and pay the Sum of Free Pounds Current Money, to be recovered and applied

And be it furt ber Enacied and Declared, That the Constables of the several Constables to and respective Hundreds of the said Counties of Anne-Arundel and Talbot, shall, upon their knowing, or being applied to, during the Time of holding the faid mults. Yearly Meetings, by any other Perton or Perfons informing them, that great Numbers or Crowds of Negroes or other Slaves have met in a tumultuous and diforderly Manner within the faid Counties, immediately ro repair with fuch Assistance as he or they shall think necessary, to such Place where such Negroes and other Slaves shall be affembled, and require and command them immediately to disperse and retire to their several Dwellings; which if they, or any of them, shall refuse or delay to do, or shall behave impudently or turbulently, such Constable or Constables shall seize and take such Negro or Negroes, or other Slave or Slaves, so retuing, delaying, or misbehaving, and give him, her, or them, a due Correction, by whipping on the bare Back with any Number of Stripes not exceeding Thirty-Nine.

Provided Always, That nothing herein shall extend, or be construed to ex- Provide. tend, to prevent, hinder, or preclude any licensed Ordinary-Keeper, whose settled Dwelling shall happen to be within three Miles of, or a greater Distance frem such Meeting-Houses, or either of them, from erecting or building any Booths, or other Conveniencies, for the better accommodating and refreshing Persons going to or returning from such Meetings, so that the same be at his or her dwelling House, and subject to the several other Restrictions and Limitations herein before expressed, or from selling such Liquors or Accommodations in such dwelling House.

This Act to continue from and after the End of this prefent Seffion of Affemely, for and during the space of three Years, and unto the End of the next Continuance ession of Assembly which shall happen after the Expiration of the said three Years.
