Pounds Current Money, together with the Sheriff's Salary of Five hundred Pounds Current Money, together with the Sheriff's Salary of Five per Cent. for Collection; and when the same is so levied and assessed, to pay the same to the Representatives of the County for the Time being, who are hereby athorized and required to apply the Five hundred Pounds aforesaid to the wilding, finishing and compleating a convenient Goal in the said County are and convenient to the new Court-House so as aforesaid to be erected, and such Goal shall be taken, held, and deemed to be the proper Goal of the sourt County.

Levying of Money for building a Goal.

And be it further Enasted by the Authority aferesaid, That the Commissioners is as aforesaid appointed by this Act, shall be, and they are new authorized and impowered, to employ some able and skilful Person overlook the Workman or Workmen so by them employed, in building, said ing and compleating the Court-House aforesaid, and to pay such Person for his Trouble therein, such reasonable Reward, as by them the said commissioners, or the major Part of them, and the said Person, shall be greed upon.

relating to Servants and Slaves.

PHEREAS by an Act of Assembly of this Province, made at a Seffion of Affembly begun and held at the City of Annapolis, the Twenth-fixth Day of April, Anno Domini, One thousand seven hundred and fisteen, Entituled, An Ast relating to Serwants and Slaves, it is Enacted, That any Person or Persons whatsoever ti met mall, after the Publication of the said Act, wittingly or willingly en-* Frain any Servant or Slave, unlawfully absenting him, her or themselves in their Master, Mistress, Dame or Overseer, shall be fined Five hundred F sunds of Tobacco, for every Night or Twenty-four Hours that such Perso or Persons shall give such Entertainment. And whereas it is reprehe sited to this General Assembly, that many crafty and ill-disposed Persons It mowing that they are not liable to the Payment of the said Fine, unless they en atertain such Servant or Slave one whole Night, or Twenty-sour Hours, w ithout Intermission, do, by frequently entertaining the Servants and Il aves of the good People of this Province at dead Times of Night, for fewe ral Hours together, entice them fecretly to make away with and embezel the: Goods of their Masters or Owners, by carrying them to such Entertal aments, and to commit many grievous Diforders and Irregularities against the Prace of his Lordship, and his good Rule and Government, and to the grea I Damage and Disquiet of many of his Majesty's liege Subjects within this Province: For preventing which Evils for the suture;

Preamble.

Be it Enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Ippear and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That if any Person or Persons, after the End of this Session of Assembly, hall wittingly or willingly entertain any Servant or Servants, Slave or laves, unlawfully absenting him, her or themselves from his, her or their faster, Owner or Overseer, or permitter suffer them to be about their Houses. Plan tations during the Space of one Hour, or longer, such Person or writing or suffering them to be about their Houses or Plantations, shall so serve and pay at the Rate of One hundred Pounds of Tobacco for every
