Penalty.

Hour each Servant or Slave shall be by him, her or them so entertained or partitle of suffered to be about his, her or their House or Plantation as all refaid, to be recovered in a summary Way, before a single Magistrate, with Costs if the Penalty does not exceed Six hundred Pounds of Tobacco; and does exceed Six hundred Pounds of Tobacco, then to be recovered by Action of Debt, Bill of Indictment, Plaint or Information, in the Cost that Court where the Offence shall be committed, wherein no Essoin, Protect for Wager of Law, or above one Imparlance, shall be allowed; the one shall whereof shall be applyed to the Use of the public School of the Gostalty wherein such Forseiture shall happen, and the other half to the Party grieved, provided he or she shall prosecute for the same within three Mc anthe next after the Offence committed, otherwise to the Informer or him or them who shall sue for the same; Provided such Suit be commenced within twelve Months after such Offence committed.

If unable to pay the Fine, then to be whipt.

And he it further Enacted, That if it shall appear to any Magistre we, before whom any Conviction for Breach of this Act shall be had, that the Offender is unable to pay or give good Security for the Penalty aforest his, it shall and may be lawful for such Magistrate to punish such Offender I we Whipping on the bare back with such Number of Stripes, not exceeding thirty-nine for any one Offence, as to him shall seem meet, and to require Security for the good Behaviour of such Offender for and during the Tento of six Months then next following.

In case one Servant or Slave entertains another, then to be punish by by Whipping. And be it further Enacted, That if any Servant or Slave shall witting or willingly harbour or entertain any other Servant or Servants, Slave slaves, unlawfully absent from his, her or their Master, Owner or Overse for and during the Space of one Hour or longer, it shall and may be say ful for any Magistrate, and he is hereby required, upon Complaint to his made, immediately to issue his Warrant against such Servant or Slave sharbouring or entertaining as aforesaid, and upon satisfactory Proof of such harbouring or entertaining, to punish the Offender or Offenders by Whisping with such Number of Stripes, on the bare Back, as to him shall see may proper, not exceeding thirty-nine for any one Offence.

Sheriffs to read this Act every Court.

And be it further Enacted, That the several Sheriff's of this Provinc ic shall read this Act on the Wednesday in each respective County Court, in sulf Court, having first given publick Notice of such Reading by Proclamation not the several Ordinaries or Houses of Entertainment near to the Court House, on pain of sorseiting Five hundred Pounds of Tobacco for eye sy. Omission or Neglect, to be recovered and applyed as aforesaid.

Continuance.

This Act to continue for three Years, and to the End of the next Sell ion of Assembly which shall happen after the Expiration of three Years.
