Be it Enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That the said recited Act, and every Article, Clause, and Thing, therein contained, shall be in sull Force, and is hereby made perpetual.

E it Enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That an Act of Assembly of this Province entituled, An Act to enable the several and respective County Clerks within this Province to remove some of the County Records and Papers, from the Public Offices, made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis, the tenth Day of May, One thousand seven hundred forty and eight, be, and is hereby continued, and thall remain and be in full Force, for and during the Term of three Years, next ensuing, and to the End of the next Session of Assembly, which shall happen after the End of the said three Years.
