tors, for each and every of the faid Inspections, by this Act above established, and shall forthwith transmit to the Governor or Commander in Chief, for the Time being, Certificates of fuch Nomination and Recommendation, in the same Manner as in like Cases is required and directed.

And be it further Enacted, That the Inspectors so to be chosen and appointed, and who shall accept of the Office of Inspectors at the said Warehouses, shall, and they are hereby obliged to give their constant Attendance at the said Warehouses respectively, three Days in every Week, between the faid ninth Day of November and the last Day of August then next, and so yearly and every Year during the Continuance of this Act, for the Performance of their Duty as Inspectors at the said Warehouses respectively: And that there shall be paid to the said Inspectors, which shall attend at the faid Warehouses by this Act as aforesaid divided and established, the Salaries hereafter mentioned; that is to fay, to each Inspector for the Warehouse at Tover's, the Sum of Twenty-five Pounds Current Money per Annum, and no more; and to each Inspector for the Warehouse on Langford's Bay, the Sum of Twenty-five Pounds Current Money per Annum, and no more; any other Act to the contrary notwithstanding.
