are on or near the Place where the faid Church is to be built in Pursuance

of the faid Agreement,

II. AND whereas, soon after the making the said Agreement and Bond with sufficient Surety being taken, for the said Waste his complying there. with, the Majority of the Vestrymen of the said Parish, at a Meeting of the faid Vestry, did, in Pursuance of their said Agreement, draw an Order on the Sheriff of the faid County, in whole Hands the Tobacco for the first Year's Assessment then was, to pay the same to the said Waite, which Payment the said Sheriff resuled to make, because the said Order was not signed by the Churchwardens for the said Parish, by Means of which Resulal, the faid Waite hath not yet received any of the Tobacco which has been levyed by Virtue of the faid Act, but the same still remains in the Hands of the said Sheriff: In order therefore, that the said Agreement for the Building the said Church may be executed, and the Contract made by the said Vestrymen, on their Part, discharged, it is prayed that it may be Enacted,

III. AND be it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprie. Sheriff enjointary, by and with the Advice and Confent of his Lordship's Governor, and wm. Waite the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, what Tobac-That all the Tobacco now in the Hands of the laid Sheriff by him received, his Hands, on by Virtue of the faid Act, he shall be obliged, and is hereby enjoined and the Order of directed to pay unto the faid William Waite, his Executors, Administrators, the Vestry. or Assigns, on his or their procuring an Order, drawn on the said Sheriff for the same, signed by the Majority of the Vestrymen of the said Parish; any Thing in the said Act contained to the centrary thereof in any wise notwith-

standing.

IV. AND be it farther Enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That in Remedy in Case the said Sheriff shall, after the producing to him the said Order, resuse susal. or delay to pay the Tobacco due thereon, the said Vestrymen or their Successors, shall and may have the same Remedy for the said Tobacco, or such Part thereof as shall not be paid, as other public Creditors legally may have against Sheriffs, who, after receiving Tobacco assessed for them, resule or

delay to pay the same.

V. AND be it farther Enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That To pay future when and as often as any future Collection of Tobacco shall be made, by Collections. Virtue of the said Ac, the same Tobacco so collected yearly, shall in each Year, be paid by the Sheriff of the faid County to the Order of the Majority of the Vestrymen of the said Parish, in discharge of the Agreement made with the said William Waite, until the said Quantity of One Hundred and Forty Thousand Pounds of Tobacco in the laid Act and Agreement mentioned, shall be fully paid and satisfied.

An Act for the speedy Recovery of small Debts out of Court, before One Justice of the Peace.

THEREAS the Recovery of small Debts before One Justice of Preamble. the Peace out of Court, has been found a great Satisfaction and Ease to the good People of this Province, and that the Jurisdiction of one Justice of the Peace, by the Law heretofore made, is not sufficiently extended to suit their Conveniency and Benefit: It is therefore humbly prayed that it may be enacted;

II. AND be it Enasted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the Same, That in all Cases wherein the real Debt or Damage doth not exceed Six Hundred Pounds of Tobacco, or Fifty Shillings Current Money, it shall and may be lawful
