

XXVI. AND be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That no Officer or Commander of any Company, or Person employing any Cart or Waggon in Virtue of this Act, shall constrain or compel the Owner or Driver of such Cart or Waggon to travel more than Fifteen Miles in any one Day, on Pain of forfeiting the Sum of Five Pounds Current Money; to be recovered before One Provincial Justice, or Two Justices of the Peace, where the Offence shall be committed, and applied as the Fines and Forfeitures herein before are directed to be applied. *Provided nevertheless*, That if the Exigency of the Service should make it necessary for any Carriage, employed within this Province in his Majesty's Service, to travel more than Fifteen Miles in one Day, then and in such Case the Owner or Driver of such Carriage shall proceed farther; but for every Mile that he shall travel that Day with the Carriage, above the Fifteen Miles, he may demand and shall receive the Sum of One Shilling and Four Pence per Mile if a Waggon, and One Shilling per Mile if a Cart, over and above the Sum of Twelve Shillings and Six Pence, or the Sum of Ten Shillings, before allowed for a Day's Hire.

Carts or Waggon to go no more than 15 Miles in a Day,

Except on some Exigency.

XXVII. AND whereas it may be necessary to make Provision for Intelligence, and other Contingencies, which it is impossible particularly to express and specify in this Act; *Be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid*, That it shall and may be lawful to and for the Governor or Commander in Chief of this Province, for the Time being, from Time to Time, during the Continuance of this Act, to draw his Order on the Agents aforesaid, for any Sum or Sums of Money not exceeding, in the Whole, the Sum of Fifty Pounds Current Money, payable to such Person or Persons as he shall think fit; and the said Agents are hereby directed and required to pay all such Orders, so as aforesaid drawn, the Governor or Commander in Chief, for the Time being, expressing in such Order the particular Use or Purpose for which the same is, are, or shall be drawn.

The Governor to draw on the Agents, for the Payment of Expenses.

XXVIII. AND be it further Enacted, That such Parts of the Act first herein mentioned, as relate to the granting a Sum not exceeding Three Thousand Pounds, to be laid out and employed in engaging the Assistance and cultivating the Friendship of the Southern Tribes of Indians, and the defraying the Expences of Two Commissioners to be sent from this Province to treat with the same, in Conjunction with the Commissioners from Pennsylvania, Virginia, and North-Carolina, or any of them, and appointing the said Commissioners, shall be and are hereby utterly repealed and made void.

XXIX. This Act to continue until the Twenty-fifth Day of December, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty-seven, and no longer.

Continuance.

An Act continuing an Act, entituled, *An Act for the Advancement of Justice.*

BE it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That an Act of Assembly of this Province, entituled, *An Act for the Advancement of Justice*, made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis on the second Day of October, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty-three, shall be, and is hereby continued and shall remain and be in full Force, for and during the Term of Three Years, and unto the End of the next Session of Assembly which shall happen after the Expiration of the said Three Years.

An Act continuing an Act, entituled, *An Act for Relieving the Inhabitants of this Province from some Aggrievances in the Prosecution of Suits at Law*, and for continuing the Supplementary Act thereto.

BE it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That an Act of Assembly of this Province, entituled, *An Act for Relieving the Inhabitants of this Province from some Aggrievances in the Prosecution of Suits at Law*, made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis the Twenty-second Day of June, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Fourteen: and also one other Act, entituled, *A Supplementary Act to the Act for Relieving the Inhabitants of this Province from some Aggrievances in the Prosecution of Suits at Law*, made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis the Third Day of October, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Twenty-eight; be, and are hereby continued to be and remain in full Force, for and during the Term of Three Years, and unto the End of the next Session of Assembly which shall happen after the Expiration of the said Three Years.
