Company, or Person employing any Cart or Waggon in Virtue of this Act, thall constrain or compel the Carts or Wag-Ounce or Driver of such Cart or Waggon to travel more than Fisteen Miles in any one Day, on Pain of sons to go an forfeiting the Sum of Five Pounds Current Money; to be recovered before One Provincial Justice, or Two more than 15 befores of the Peace where the Offence shall be committed, and applied as the Fines and Forseitures herein sefore are directed to be applied. Provided nevertheless, That if the Exigency of the Service should make hefore are directed to be appared. I rectain in december, I had it the Exigency of the Service mould make a necessary for any Carriage, employed within this Province in his Majesty's Service, to travel more than Fifteen Miles in one Duy, then and in fuch Case the Owner or Driver of such Carriage shall proceed farther; Except on some but for every Mile that he shall travel that Day with the Carriage, above the Fisteen Miles, he may demand and shall receive the Sum of One Shilling and Four Pence per Mile if a Waggon, and One Shilling per Mile if a Cast, over and above the Sum of Twelve Shillings and Six Pence, or the Sum of Ten Shillings. before allowed for a Day's Hire.

XXVII. A N D whereas it may be necessary to make Provision for Intelligence, and other Contingencies, The Governor which it is impossible particularly to express and specify in this Act; Be it further Exacted by the Authority to draw on the appreciand, That it shall and may be lawful to and for the Governor or Commander in Chief of this Pro-Agents, for the vince, for the Time being, from Time to Time, during the Continuance of this Act, to draw his Order Payment of Exon the Agency aforefaid, for any Sum or Sums of Money not exceeding, in the Whole, the Sum of Fifty preffes. Pounds Current Money, payable to fach Person or Persons as he shall think sit; and the said Agents are hereby directed and required to pay all such Orders, so as assorbaid drawn, the Governor or Commander in Chief, for the Time being, expressing in fach Order the particular Use or Purpose for which the same is, are, or thall be drawn.

XXVIII. AND be it further Ensated, That such Parts of the Act first herein mentioned, as relate to the Part of a former runting a Sum not exceeding Three Thousand Pounds, to be laid out and employed in engaging the As- At Repealed. fiftence and cultivating the Friendthip of the Southern Tribes of Indians, and the defraying the Expences of Two Commissioners to be sent from this Province to treat with the same, in Conjunction with the Commishoners from Panelylevania, Virginia, and North-Carolina, or any of them, and appointing the faid Commisfoners, shall be and are hereby offerly repealed and made void.

XXIX. This Act to continue until the Twenty-fifth Day of December, One Thousand Seven Hundred Continuance. and Fifty feven, and no longer.

That an Act of Assembly of this Province, entituled, An Act for the Advancement of Justice, made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis on the second Day of October, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty-three, shall be, and is hereby continued and hall remain and be in full Force, for and during the Term of Three Years, and unto the End of the next Selion of Assembly which shall happen after the Expiration of the said Three Years.

E it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of An Ast con-bis Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Anthority of the same, tinued. That an Ast of Assembly of this Province, entituled, An Ast for Relieving the Inhabitants of this Province from some Aggrievances in the Prosecution of Saits at Law, made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapalis the Twenty-second Day of June, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Fourteen; and also one other Ad, entituled, A Supplementary Ad to the Ad for Relieving the Inhabitants of this Province from some Aggriculances in the Projecution of Saits at Law, made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Assemblis the Third Day of October, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Twenty-eight; be, and are hereby continued to be and remain in full Force, for and during the Term of Three Years, and unto the End of the next Session of Assembly which shall happen after the Expiration of the faid Three Years.
