An Act continuing an Act, entitled, An additional Supplementary Act to the Act, entitled, An Act relating to Servants and Slaves.

An Act continued.

BE it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietors, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Majesty's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That an Act of Assembly of this Province, entitled, *An additional Supplementary Act to the Act, entitled, An Act relating to Servants and Slaves, made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis, the Tenth Day of May, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Forty Eight, &c.* and is hereby continued, and shall remain and be in full Force, for and during the Term of Three Years next ensuing, and to the End of the next Session of Assembly which shall happen after the End of the said Three Years.

An Act continuing an Act, entitled, An Act for the more effectual Punishment of Negroes and other Slaves; and for taking away the Benefit of Clergy from certain Offenders; and a Supplementary Act to an Act, entitled, An Act to prevent the tumultuous Meeting, and other Irregularities, of Negroes and other Slaves, and directing the Manner of trying Slaves.

BE it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietors, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Majesty's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That an Act of Assembly of this Province, entitled, *An Act for the more effectual Punishment of Negroes and other Slaves; and for taking away the Benefit of Clergy from certain Offenders; and a Supplementary Act to an Act, entitled, An Act to prevent the tumultuous Meeting, and other Irregularities, of Negroes and other Slaves, and directing the Manner of trying Slaves, made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis the Fifteenth Day of May, Anno Domini One Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty One, &c.* and is hereby continued, and shall remain and be in full Force, for and during the Term of Three Years next ensuing, and to the End of the next Session of Assembly which shall happen after the End of the said Three Years.
