the Lower House of Assembly within Four Months, respectively, after the End of every such Session, during the Continuance of this Act, to the Governor, and each Member of the Upper and Lower Houses of Affembly, and one Book of the Votes and Proceedings to the Clerk of each House, and Three Books of the Votes and Proceedings aforefaid to the Clerks of the feveral and respective County Courts, for the Perusal of the Inhibitants of the feveral and respective Counties, and a Copy of the Public Laws, during the Continuance of this Act, to every Provincial and County Magistrate, and a Copy of each Law bound up in Leather, to each House of Assembly, the High Court of Appeals, the Provincial Court, and to each County Court within this Province.

Proviso.

II. AND be it likewife Enacted, That if it should so happen, that in any Year during the Continuance of this Act, there should not be any Session of Assembly held within this Province, whereby the said Jonas Green may be enabled to Print Laws, and deliver them within such Year, that then and in such Case, there shall be allowed to the said Jonas Green the several and respective Sums of Current Money, in the several Counties within this Province, following, to wit, In Baltimore County, Twenty-four Pounds Five Shillings: Anne-Arundel County, Twenty Pounds: Charles County, Eighteen Pounds Ten Shillings: Prince-George's County, Eighteen Younds: Frederick County, Sixteen Pounds Five Shillings: Queen-Anne's County, Fifteen Pounds Fifteen Shillings: Saint Mary's County, Fourteen Pounds Ten Shillings: Dorchefter County, Fourteen Pounds: Kent County, Thirteen Pounds Fifteen Shillings: Talbot County, Twelve Pounds Ten Shillings: Somerset County, Eleven Pounds Fifteen Shillings: Worcester County, Eleven Pounds Five Shillings: Cacil County, Eleven Pounds: And Caiwert County, Eight Pounds Ten Shillings: Which said respective Sums of Money last asorementioned, together with the Sheriff's Salary of Five Pounds per Cent for Collecting the fame, the faid Justices of the several County Courts within this Province, are hereby impowered and required to allow and assess in their respective County Levy, and shall be by the respective Sheriffs collected, and yearly paid to the faid Jonas Green, in Manner and Form aforesaid, for his better Support and Encouragement in serving this Province, and residing within the same.

III. PROVIDED always, That the faid Jonas Green shall actually reside at Annapolis during the Continuance of this Act, and comply with the Terms thereof; and that upon the Death of the faid Jonas Green, or his Removal from Annapolis, or ceasing to comply with the Terms of this Act on his Part, the Payment of the Sums of Money herein before directed to be paid to him, shall cease; any Thing contained in this

Act, to the contrary, notwithstanding.

IV. AND be it likewise Enacted, I hat the Copy of the Public Laws made this present Session of Assembly, as well as those made at any future Session, during the Continuance of this Act, shall have marginal Notes made and printed thereto, as also the Date of the Year, wherein such Laws were respectively made, inserted in each Page, and a List of such Laws made at the End of each Session, with the Page where they are Printed; all which the faid Jonas Green is hereby required and obliged to do, as well as all other Ser-

vices herein before mentioned, for the yearly Salary aforesaid.

V. AND whereas the last Law for the Encouragement of the said Jonas Green, did expire the Second Day of April, in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty-one, whereby the faid Jonas Green had no Allowance from this Province for the Year One Thousand Seven Hundred and Sixtyone aforesaid : Be it therefore Enacted, That there shall be allowed to the said Jonas Green, for his Services in the said Year, the several and respective Sums of Current Money, in the several Counties within this Province, sollowing, to wit, In Baltimore County, Twenty-sour Pounds Five Shillings: Anne-Arundel County, Twenty Pounds: Charles County, Eighteen Pounds Ten Shillings: Prince-George's County, Eighteen Pounds: Frederick County, Sixteen Founds Five Shillings: Queen-Anne's County, Fifteen Pounds Fifteen Shillings: Saint Mary's County, Fourteen Pounds Ten Shillings: Dorchefter County, Fourteen Pounds: Kent County, Thirteen Pounds Fifteen Shillings: Taibot County, Twelve Pounds Ten Shillings: Somerset County, Eleven Pounds Fifteen Shillings: Warcester County, Eleven Pounds Five Shillings: Cacil County, Eleven Pounds: And Calvert County, Eight Pounds Ten Shillings: Which said respective Sums of Money last mentioned, together with the Sheriff's Salary of Five Pounds per Cent for Collecting the same, the said Justices of the several County Courts within this Province, are hereby impowered and required to allow and assess in their next respective County Levies, and shall be by the respective Sheriffs collected and paid to the faid Jonas Green, in Manner and Form aforesaid.

VI. PROVIDED always, and be it hereby Enacted, That it shall and may be lawful for the Taxable Inhabitants of this Province, upon whom the above Sums of Money shall be affested, to discharge and pay the same in Gold and Silver, at the same Rates as by the Act, entituled, An Act for amending the Staple of Tobacco, for preventing Frauds in his Majesty's Customs, and for the Limitation of Officers Fecs, made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis the second Day of October, in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Fisty-three, Gold and Silver is directed to be received in all Payments made in Virtue of that Act.

VII. PROVIDED also, That it shall and may be lawful for the Sheriffs of the several and respective Counties respectively, and they are hereby required not to pay to the said Jonas Green the said respective Sums of Money herein before mentioned, or any Part thereof, to be assessed and levied for his Use, for his Salary for this present or any suture Year, during the Continuance of this Act, unless it shall be made appear to them by a Certificate or Receipt from the Sheriff of Anne-Arundel County, for the Time being, That the Public Laws, and the Votes and Proceedings of this Session, and every suture Session or Convention, during the Continuance of this Act, were printed and delivered to him within the respective Times herein before directed; any Thing herein before contained to the contrary, in any wife, notwithstanding.

VIII. AND be it further Enacted, That the feveral and respective Sheriffs within this Province, shall, and they are hereby directed and required to receive and forward the faid Laws, with the Votes and Proceedings aforefaid, to the Clerks of the feveral County Courts, and Members of each House of Ailembly, as Public Letters are by the Laws of this Province directed to be forwarded, and under the like Penalty. to be recovered and applied in like Manner.
