CXXXVII. And be it further Enacted, That if any Person or Persons shall C H A P. be Sued, Prosecuted, or Impleaded, for any Matter or Thing by him, her, or Persons Sued them done, pursuant to and in execution of this Act, such Person or Persons for any thing fo Sued, Prosecuted or Impleaded, shall be at Liberty to plead the General done by vir-Issue, and give this Act and the special Matter in Evidence, and if the Plain- Ac. tiff or Informer shall be Non-suit, discontinue his Suit, or a Verdict be had against him, then, and in either of these Cases, the Desendant or Desendants shall not only be acquit thereof, but shall by Judgment recover against such Plaintiff or Informer meble Costs.

CXXXVIII. Provided always, and it is hereby Enacted and Declared, Informations That every Information to be made, in pursuance of this Act, shall be made to be made in within three Months next after the Offence committed, and not after 3 Months. within three Months next after the Offence committed, and not after.

CXXXIX. And be it further Enacted, That no Master or Commander of Freight-Toany Ship or other Vessel, taking Tobacco on Freight, shall remove or transport bacco not to be carried in any Freight-Tobacco from any Warehouse, in order to be put on board his open Boats. Ship or Vessel, in any open Boat or undecked Vessel, without such good and sufficient Covering as will secure such Tobacco against Rain, under Penalty of Sixteen Hundred Pounds of Tobacco for every Offence, to be recovered in any Court of Record in this Province, by Action of Debt, Bill of Indictment, or Information, one Half thereof to the Informer, the other Half to the defraying the Charges of putting this Law in Execution.

CXL. and whereas the Inhabitants of Frederick County, above Connego- Farmers in cheague Creek, are Farmers, and are so far distant from any Justice of the Frederick County. Peace, that the Trouble and Charge attending the making Oath, or Affirmation, as to their not being Tobacco-makers, as herein before directed, lays them under unreasonable Hardships, in obtaining the Benefit intended them by this Act, in paying Money in lieu of Tobacco: Be it therefore Enacted, That the said Inhabitants in Frederick County, above Connegocheague Creek, shall, and may, make the Oath or Affirmation aforesaid, before either a Justice of the Peace of the faid County, or the Sheriff, or any of his Deputies, a Certificate of the making of which Oath or Affirmation, signed both by the Person taking, and the Person making the same, being delivered to the Sheriff or his Deputy, such Sheriff or Deputy shall give a Receipt for the same, to the Person making such Oath or Affirmation.
