Preamble.

HEREAS an Act of Assembly was made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis, on the Second Day of October, in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty-three, entitled, A Supplementary Act to the Act, entitled, An Act for the Relief of Creditors in England against Bankrupts, who have Imported Goods into this Province, not accounted for, hath since, by Experience, appeared to be a good and wholsome Law, and very beneficial to the People of this Province:

One Ast made II. Be it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That the same Ast shall be Perpetual, and is hereby continued, to be and remain in full Force for ever.
