An ACT continuing an Act, entitled, "An Act for preventing
 " Indians, disaffected to the *British* Interest in *America*, from
 " coming into this Province as Spies, or on any other evil De-
 " sign." Passed 21st of
November.

BE it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with One Act con-
tinued.
 the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governour, and the Upper and
 Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That an Act
 of Assembly of this Province, entitled, *An Act for preventing Indians, dis-*
affected to the British Interest in America, from coming into this Province as Spies,
or on any other evil Design, made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at
 the City of *Annapolis*, on the Twenty-third Day of *February*, One Thousand
 Seven Hundred and Fifty-six, shall be, and is hereby continued, to be and
 remain in full Force, for and during the Term of Three Years, and unto the
 End of the next Session of Assembly which shall happen after the Expiration
 of the said Three Years.

C H A P. IX.

An ACT continuing an Act, entitled, "An Act to prevent Persons Passed 21st of
November.
 " from secreting Boats, Flats, and other Vessels drove by Strefs
 " of Weather, or otherwise, from Landings and Moorings."

WHEREAS an Act of Assembly was made at a Session of Assembly, Preamble.
 begun and held at the City of *Annapolis*, on the Second Day of
October, in the Year of our Lord, One Thousand Seven Hundred
 and Fifty-three, entitled, *An Act to prevent Persons secreting Boats, Flats,*
and other Vessels, drove by Strefs of Weather, or otherwise, from Landings and
Moorings, hath since, by Experience, appeared to be a good and wholesome
 Law, and very beneficial to the People of this Province:

II. Be it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and One Act made
Perpetual.
 with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governour, and the Upper and Lower
 Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That the same Act shall be
 Perpetual, and is hereby continued, to be and remain in full Force for ever.

C H A P. X.

An ACT continuing an Act, entitled, "An Act to remedy some Passed 21st of
November.
 " Evils relating to Servants."

BE it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with One Act con-
tinued.
 the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governour, and the Upper and
 Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That an Act
 of Assembly of this Province, entitled, *An Act to remedy some Evils relating*
to Servants, made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of
Annapolis, the Eighth Day of *May*, Anno Domini One Thousand Seven Hun-
 dred and Fifty, be, and is hereby continued, to be and remain in full Force,
 for and during the Term of Three Years, and unto the End of the next Ses-
 sion of Assembly which shall happen after the Expiration of the said Three
 Years.

C H A P. XI.

 " ters of Ships, and Vessels, from clandestinely carrying Ser-
