A Supplementary ACT to the Act, entitled, An Act for building a Church in St. James's Parish, in Anne-Arundel County.

THEREAS the Rector, Vestry-men, Church-wardens, and Inhabi-Preamble. tants of St. James's Parish, in Anne-Arundel County, have, by their Petition to this General Assembly, represented, that the Quantity of Tobacco levied by virtue of the Act of Assembly, entitled, An Act for building a Church in St. James's Parish, in Anne-Arundel County, hath been applied towards, but is not sufficient to pay the Expences of, building and finishing the new Church, directed by the said Act to be built, that there is now the Sum of One Hundred and Thirty-seven Pounds, Seventeen Shillings, and Ten Pence, the Produce of Tobacco levied on, collected from, and paid by, the Taxable Inhabitants of the said Parish, before the passing the said Act, for repairing the old Church of the faid Parish, which was not appropriated by the said Act towards building the said new Church; and that over and above the said One Hundred and Thirty-seven Pounds, Seventeen Shillings, and Ten Pence, the Quantity of Eighty Thousand Pounds of Tobacco will be necessary, for the compleatly finishing the said new Church, and inclosing the Church Yard thereto; they have therefore prayed that an Act may pass, to appropriate the said Sum of Money, and also to impower the Justices of the faid County Court, to levy on the Taxable Inhabitants of the faid Parish, the Quantity of Eighty Thousand Pounds of Tobacco, for the compleatly finishing the said new Church, and inclosing the Church Yard thereto:

II. Be it therefore Enamed, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, 80,000 th of by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Tobacco to be levied for Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That the Justices of compleating Anne-Arundel County Court, shall, and they are hereby impowered and re- St. James's quired, at the Time of their laying the County Levy of the faid County, in November Court 1765, to affess on the Taxable Inhabitants of the said Parish, the Quantity of Eighty Thousand Pounds of Tobacco, together with a Salary to the Sheriff of the faid County, for Collecting the same, of Five per Centum, and the said Sheriff is hereby impowered and directed to levy and collect the same, in the same Manner Public and County Levies are levied and collected; and shall also account for, and pay the same to, the Rector, Vestry-men, and Church-wardens of the said Parish, for the Time being, or the major Part of them, which said Tobacco, when so collected, accounted for, and paid, and also the said Sum of One Hundred and Thirty-seven Pounds, Seventeen Shillings, and Ten Pence, shall be, by the said Rector, Vestry-men, and Church-wardens, or the major Part of them, applied to the compleatly finishing the said new Church, and inclosing the said Church Yard thereto; and if any Balance thereof should remain, such Balance shall be by the said Rector, Vestry-men, and Church-wardens, or the major Part of them, applied in, and towards, the necessary Repairs of the said Parish Buildings.

III. Provided always, and be it Enacted, That every Taxable Inhabitant May be paid of the said Parish, may pay and discharge the said Assessment in Money, at as Public the Rate and in the Manner that Public and County Levies are payable; any Thing herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding.
