XII. And be it further Enacted, That in case of the Death, Removal, or In case of other Disqualification of any Clerk of the said Market, to be nominated or to nominate appointed by the Justices of the said County Court, or the Commissioners a-new. of the Town aforesaid, immediately thereupon, or as soon as may be, the Commissioners of the said Town, or the major Part of them, shall nominate and appoint some other Person duly qualified as aforesaid, to be Clerk until the last Day of the November Court then next ensuing, who shall have full Power and Authority, as Clerk of the Market, in every Case aforementioned.

XIII. And be it further Enafted, That every Person so nominated and ap- Clerk to give pointed, either by the Justices aforesaid, or by the Commissioners of the said Bond, &c. Town, as Clerk of the faid Market, shall, before he takes on himself the Execution of the said Office, enter into Bond, with Two sufficient Securities, in the Sum of Two Hundred Pounds Current Money, to the Commissioners of the faid Town of Baltimore, for the Time being, with Condition thereto, that he will well and faithfully discharge his Duty, agreeable to the Act of Assembly, entitled, An Act to confirm a Lease made by Thomas Harrison of Baltimore County, for Part of a Lot of Land therein mentioned, lying in Baltimore-Town, in Said County, to the Commissioners of the Said Town, and their Successors, and to establish a Market in the Jaid Town, and for the Regulation of the Jaid Market, and a just and true Account render of all such Monies as he shall receive by virtue of his Office, and that he will pay and apply such Monies, so received, as the Commission as aforesaid, for the Time being, or the major Part of them, order and direct.

XIV. And be it surther Enacted, by the Authority, Advice, and Consent a- No Person to forefaid, That it shall not be lawful for any Person whatever, wilfully to lead, lead, ride, or forefaid, That it shall not be lawful for any Person whatever, wilfully to lead, lead, ride, or ride, or drive into the aforesaid Market-House, any Horse, Gelding, Mare, or kill in the or Colt, or to kill or slaughter in the said House, any Beast of the Beef, Sheep, Marketor Hog kind, under the Penalty of Two Shillings and Six-pence Current House. XVI. This Act to continue Seven Years, and unto the End of the next Duration. Session of Assembly which shall happen after the Expiration of the said Seven Years.
