

settle and ascertain the respective future Limits of the said Parishes, by such natural and artificial Bounds and Lines, as to them, or the major Part of them, shall appear to be most conducive to the Ends and Intention of this Act, and shall finish and compleat the same Division, on or before the Twentieth Day of *May* next.

V. **Provided** always, That the said Commissioners, in laying out a-new, and dividing the said Parishes, shall have regard to the Number of Taxables to be contained in each Parish, so as to leave the yearly Income of *St. Luke's* Parish as near the Sum of Forty-five Thousand Pounds of Tobacco, and the yearly Income of *St. Paul's* Parish, as near the Sum of Forty Thousand Pounds of Tobacco, as conveniently may be, with respect to the Facility of the said Division, and the Intention of this Act.

Regard to be had to the Number of Taxables, &c.

VI. **And** be it further Enacted, That the said Commissioners, or the major Part of them, as soon as conveniently may be, after they shall have laid out a-new the said Parishes, shall cause the said Surveyor to make out Two distinct and fair Certificates of the Bounds and Limits, as well natural as artificial, of each of the said Parishes, so as aforesaid, to be by them settled and ascertained; and one other such Certificate of the Bounds and Limits of each of the said Parishes, which shall extend into *Talbot* County, which Certificate shall be signed by the said Commissioners, or the major Part of them and the said Surveyor, one of which Certificates of the Bounds and Limits of each Parish, shall be returned by the said Commissioners to the County Court which shall be next after the making and compleating the Division aforesaid, held for *Queen-Anne's* and *Talbot* Counties respectively, in the Month of *June* next, and one other to the Vestry of each Parish respectively, at their next Meeting after the making and compleating the said Division.

Certificates of the Bounds &c. to be made, signed, and lodg'd with the Clerks.

VII. **And** be it further Enacted, That upon the Return of the said Certificates, the said County Courts shall cause the Clerks of the said Courts respectively to enrol the same among the Land Records of the said Courts, and the Vestry of each Parish aforesaid shall cause the Certificate of the Bounds and Limits of their Parish to be entered in the Register of their Proceedings; and the Bounds and Limits of the said Parishes being so as aforesaid certified, inrolled, and entered in the Registers, shall be, and shall thereafter be deemed and held to be the true and certain Bounds and Limits of the said Parishes respectively, any former Law to the contrary notwithstanding.

The same to be enroll'd by the County Clerks,

and Parish Registers.

VIII. **And** be it further Enacted, That the said Commissioners shall, together with the Certificates aforesaid, return to the said County Court of *Queen-Anne's* County, the Book containing the Entries of their Proceedings in the Premises, which shall be carefully kept and preserved by the Clerk of the said Court.

Also their Book of Entries.

IX. **And** be it further Enacted, That the said County Courts of *Queen-Anne's*, and *Talbot* Counties, on Receipt of the said Certificates, shall, at their said Courts to be held in the Month of *June* next, respectively, regulate, and lay out a-new, if need be, the several Hundreds contained in the said Parishes, in such Manner that each of the said Parishes shall contain Entire Hundreds.

Hundreds to be laid out a-new, if necessary.

X. **And** be it further Enacted, That each of the said Commissioners shall be allowed the Sum of Sixty-four Pounds of Tobacco for each Day he shall attend in the Execution of this Act, and the Surveyor of the County aforesaid shall be allowed the Sum of Eighty Pounds of Tobacco for each Day he shall attend in the Execution of this Act, and the said Clerk to the Commissioners shall be allowed the Sum of Sixty-four Pounds of Tobacco for each Day he shall

Allowance to the Commissioners, &c. in executing this Act.
