**B**E it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That an Act of Assembly of this Province, entitled, *An Act for the speedy Recovery of Small Debts out of Court, before one Justice of the Peace*, made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis, the Fourth Day of October, Seventeen Hundred and Sixty-three, be, and is hereby continued, and shall remain and be in full Force, for and during the Term of Seven Years, and to the End of the next Session of Assembly which shall happen after the End of the said Seven Years. *Continued Session 1773 Sept 13 for 7 years*

An ACT continuing an Act, entitled, *An Act for the Gauge of Barrels for Pork, Beef, Pitch, Tar, Turpentine, and Tare of Barrels for Flour and Bread.*

**B**E it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That an Act of Assembly of this Province, entitled, *An Act for the Gauge of Barrels for Pork, Beef, Pitch, Tar, Turpentine, and Tare of Barrels for Flour and Bread*, made at a Session of Assembly begun and held at the City of Annapolis, on the Fifth Day of August, Seventeen Hundred and Forty-five, be, and is hereby continued, and shall remain and be in full Force, for and during the Term of Seven Years, and unto the End of the next Session of Assembly which shall happen after the Expiration of the said Seven Years. *Continued Session Sept 15 for 7 years*

The Act of 1750, ch. 5, continued 7 Years, &c.

**B**E it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That an Act of Assembly of this Province, entitled, *An Act to remedy some Evils relating to Servants*, made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis, the Eighth Day of May, Seventeen Hundred and Fifty, be, and is hereby continued, and shall remain and be in full Force, for and during the Term of Seven Years next ensuing, and unto the End of the next Session of Assembly which shall happen after the End of the said Seven Years. *Continued Session 1773 Sept 12 for 7 years*
