THEREAS great Mischiess have arisen from the Landing of Goods Preamble. and Passengers from Ships and other Vessels coming into this Province with Servants and German Passengers, by communicating to, and spreading amongst the Inhabitants, dangerous infectious Distempers, begun at first by Numbers of People being closely confined together for long Times in a small Space:

II. Be it therefore Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, Masters of by and with the Advice and Confent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper Vessels to be and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the Same, That no Ship they have no or Vessel whatsoever, coming into this Province after the First Day of infectious May next, and in which Ship or Vessel there shall be imported more than Board: Thirty Servants or Passengers, shall be admitted to make her Entry, or land or put on Shore any Goods, Passenger, or Servant, before the Master, together with Two other credible Persons, shall make Oath before the Collector, or Naval Officer, with whom such Ship or Vessel shall first enter, That neither the Small-Pox, Jail-Fever, Yellow-Fever, Flux, or any The Oath. " such dangerous infectious Distemper, is, or hath been on board such " Ship or Vessel, on her Passage, to the Knowledge or Belief of such Cap-" tain, or other Persons taking such Oath respectively:" Which Oath the faid Collector, or Naval Officer, is hereby impowered and directed, perfonally, or by their Deputies, to administer, and a Certificate thereof give, without Fee or Reward.
