X. And be it further Enacted, That the Justices of the said County Court, C H A P. or the major Part of them, are hereby authorised, impowered, and required, The Justices after the said Records shall be removed, as aforesaid, to make Sale, by way authorised to of Public Vendue, of the said old Court-House and Prison, with the Land make Sale of the Courtthereto belonging, to the best and highest Bidder; and to convey the same, House and in Fee-Simple, to the Purchaser, his Heirs, and Assigns, for ever; and the highest Bide Money, or Tobacco, that shall arise by the Sale thereof, as well as any Sur-der. plus that may remain, of the said Subscription Money, and Tobacco, to be proceeds, and levied as aforesaid, shall be applied to the Use of the County, towards de-to be applied fraying the Charge thereof; any Law, Statute, Usage, or Custom, to the to the Use of the County. contrary, notwithstanding.

C H A P. XV.

An ACT to prevent the Exportation of Flour, Staves, and Shingles, not merchantable, from the Town of Baltimore, in Baltimore County, and to regulate the Weight of Hay, and Measure of Grain, Salt, Flax-Seed, and Fire-Wood, withinthe faid Town.

THEREAS it is represented to this General Assembly, That Dis-Preamble. coveries have lately been made of certain Deceits practifed by Millers, and others, in the Manufacture of Flour, large Quantities whereof are brought to, and sold, in the said Town of Baltimore, and from thence exported; and that frequent Disputes, and false Weight, and short Measure, happen, as well in the Weight of Hay, Measure of Grain, Salt, and Flax-Seed, as in the cording and measuring of Wood; and Advantages are taken of the ignorant and unwary, by the deceitful Practices of Skippers, Masters of Vessels and Boats; the like whereof also happens in the selling of Staves and Shingles, as well concerning the Quantity, as Quality; and it being apprehended, that if a Person or Persons, were appointed, under proper Powers, Checks, and Restrictions, and the Buyers, and Sellers, Inhabitants in, and about the said Town, were obliged to employ him, or them, to cord all Wood, garble or cull, and count all Staves and Shingles, and to inspect or determine, and by gradated Brand-Marks, distinguish the Qualities of all Flour, by the said Inhabitants, or others, respectively to be bought in, and about the said Town; and to measure by proper Measures, settled and adjusted by the County-Standard, all Sast, Grain, and Flax-Seed, that should be brought by Land, or Water, to, and sold in the said Town, would be of great Service, not only in supporting and affishing the Commerce of the said Town of Baltimore, but also in thwarting, and discountenancing, dishonourable, unmanly, and deceitful Dispositions, always injurious to a Community: For the Encouragement therefore of the said Town, and others, well disposed to forward the Trade and Advancement thereof;

II. Be it Enatted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with The Commisthe Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower sinore-Town to meet be-tween the Authority of the same, That the Commissioners of to meet be-tween the Ist Baltimore-Town, or the major Part of them, for the Time being, shall as-and 10th of femble and meet, between the First and the Tenth Day of July next, and July next, and every Year, to between the faid First and the Tenth Day of July, yearly, and every Year, nominate an during the Continuance of this Act, and then nominate and appoint a Per-Inspector of fon of good Repute and Skill, in the Goodness and Quality of Flour, to so Persons of be Inspector of Flour, within the said Town, for the Year ensuing; and also cull Staves shall nominate and appoint, any Number of Persons, not exceeding Three, and Shingles, of good Repute and Skill, in culling and garbling of Staves and Shingles, the weight of to be Cullers, Garblers, and Counters, of all Staves and Shingles, brought Hay, Measure to, and fold within the said Town, for the Year next ensuing, and also Q q q q q
