An ACT for the Adjournment and Continuance of Frederick County Court.

THEREAS several of the Attornies practising the Law, and some Preamble. other Persons having Business in the said Court, are Members of the Assembly, and obliged to attend their Duty therein;

Be it therefore Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by Frederick and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and County Court Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That all Causes, Pleas, Process, and Proceedings, either Civil or Criminal, now depending, or returnable to, the faid County Court of Frederick, to be held the Third Tuesday of June, in this present Year, shall be, and are by virtue of this Act, adjourned and continued from the said Third Tuesday of June, until the Third Tuesday of August next, and shall be in the same State and Condition, as they would be on the said Third Tuesday of June; any Law, Usage, or Custom, to the contrary, notwithstanding.
