XIX. And be it further Enacted, That if any Person, other than the Person other Persons making fuch Fair, or fetting up fuch Money, or other Thing, to be contend-ous Liquors at fuch Fair, ed for, as aforefaid, shall, at any Place of Meeting, for any of the Purposes at such Fair, for setting the like aforesaid, sell or dispose of any Wine, Rum, Brandy, Cyder, or other strong sum. Liquors, mixed or unmixed, such Person, so offending, shall forfeit and pay Five Pounds Current Money.

XX. Provided always, That nothing in this Act contained, shall extend, Proviso, with respect to Fairs or be construed to extend, to prohibit any Person from selling any strong and established by or be construed to extend, to promote any I offon Itom formation and Act of Assembly, or any Mixture of the same, at any Fair, authorised and bly, &c. or established by Act of Assembly of this Province, Charter, or Bye-Law of any when a Race Corporation, or to prohibit any licensed Ordinary-Keeper, from selling strong morethan 161. and spirituous Liquors, or any Mixture thereof, at Horse-Races, for any Sum of Money exceeding Sixteen Pounds Current Money.

XXI. Provided nevertheless, and be it Enacted, That it shall not be law- None but liful for any Person, whatsoever, other than a licensed Ordinary-Keeper, to sell, censed Ordinary-Keepers, or dispose of at any such last mentioned Harfe Dans or dispose of, at any such last mentioned Horse-Race, any Wine, Rum, to sell at such Race, under Brandy, Cyder, or other strong Liquors, or any Mixture thereof, under Pain Penalty of 30s. of forfeiting, for every Quantity of the same, sold at one Time, to one or more Persons, Thirty Shillings Current Money.

XXII. And be it surther Enacted, That it shall not be lawful for any Per- or allowed to fon (except licensed Ordinary-Keepers, at the Time of Horse-Racing, as afore-except at Fairs faid) at any Time to set up, or cause to be set up, a Booth, or other Con-established as above, under venience, on, or near any Public Road, or at any other Place, except where the like Pe-Fairs established by Act of Assembly, Charter, or Bye-Law of any Corpora- nalty. tion, are held, and sell or dispose of, thereat, any Wine, Rum, Brandy, Cyder, or other strong Liquors, mixt or unmixt, under the Penalty of Thirty Shillings Current Money, for every Quantity sold at any one Time, to one or more Persons.

XXIII. Provided always, and be it Enacted, That it shall not be lawful Penalty on Ordinaryfor any licensed Ordinary-Keeper, to sell or dispose of, after Sun-set, at the Keepers sel-Time and Place of Horse-racing aforesaid, any such strong or spirituous Li-ling after Sun set. quors, or mixt Drink, on Pain of forfeiting, for every fuch Offence, Five Pounds Current Money.

XXIV.
