B. as Overseer of the Alms, and Work-House, in - County, Shall faithful diswell and truly discharge his Duty, in the said Station; and more particularly, ac-charge of his conding to the Directions of the Ass. I do not be Directions of the Ass. cording to the Directions of the Act of Affembly, entitled, An Act for the Relief of the Poor, within the several Counties therein mentioned; then the above Obligation to be void, otherwise to remain in full Force and Virtue in Law.

XII. And be it further Enacted, That the said Trustees, or the major Part and to be reof them, shall, and they are hereby directed and impowered, to remove such moved at the Discretion of Overseer, and all other Officers, by them to be appointed, in pursuance of this the Trustees. Act, at their Discretion, and to proceed to choose others in their Place and Stead.

XIII. And be it further Enacted, That the said Trustees, or the major Part Trustees of them, shall, and they are hereby directed and enjoined, to meet, at the Alms, and Alms, and Work-House, in each respective County, Four Times in the Year, Work-Houses a to wit; in the First Week of February, May, August, and November, of Year, to make oftener, if it should by them be deemed necessary; to make and ordain, by Rules for the Government, a Majority of Votes, of such as may be present, all such good and wholesome and Support Ordinances, Rules, and Bye-Laws, as they shall think convenient and necesfary, for the Direction, Government, and Support of fuch Alms, and Work-House; and also for the Maintainance and Employment of all such poor Persons as shall be taken under their Care, and of all Vagrants, Beggars, Vac gabonds, and other Offenders, that shall be committed thereto, by virtue of this Act; all which Ordinances, Rules, and Bye-Laws, shall be, from Time to Time, inviolably observed by all Persons concerned, according to the Tenor and Effect thereof.

XIV. And be it further Enaced, That the said Overseer shall keep a fair The Overseer and regular List of all Poor, Beggars, Vagrants, Vagabonds, and other Of- to keep a refenders, who shall be committed to their respective Alms, and Work-Houses; all Poor, Vaand also fair and regular Accounts, in Writing, of all Materials, and other and also fair Things, coming to his Hands, as Overseer aforesaid; and of all Expences and Accounts of Charges, attending their Maintainance and Support; and of all Monies, re- and Monies, ceived by him, for the Sale of the Produce of their Labour, and otherwise, received for the Produce of as Overseer aforesaid, and shall lay the said Lists and Accounts before the Labour. Trustees, or the major Part of them, at their Meetings, at the Times by this Act directed, or oftener, if by them required.

XV. And be it further Enaced, That the said Overseer, may compel and To compel oblige any of the said Poor, Beggars, Vagrants, and Vagabonds, or other Of-sufficient Abifenders, in their respective Alms, and Work-Houses, if of sufficient Ability by to work, to labour and work, and the Produce of their Labour, he is hereby directed and impowered to fell, and apply the Money, arifing from fuch Sale, to their Maintainance and Support.

. XVI. And be it further Enacted, That upon Complaint made, that any On Complaint Person, from his, or her disorderly Conduct, gives Disturbance to his, or her made, and founded, a-Neighbourhood, and is likely to become chargeable to the faid County, City, gainst disoror Town-Corporate, it shall and may be lawful, for any one Magistrate of a single Magisthe said County, City, or Town-Corporate, respectively, if, upon hearing trate may commit such the Party, he shall adjudge the Complaint to be well founded, to commit Person to the fuch disorderly Person, residing within the said County, City, or Town-Cor- &c. unless Seporate, respectively, to the said Work-House, for any Time, not exceeding curity shall be Three Months, unless he, or she shall find Security, at the Discretion of the good Behavi-Magistrate our.
