XX. And be it further Enacted, That every Personswho-shall be received c into any Alms, or Work-House, and there receive Relief, shall, upon the Persons re-Shoulder of the Right Sleeve of the uppermost Garment of every such Person, ceived into in an open and visible Manner, wear such Badge or Mark, as is herein after any Alms, or work-House, mentioned and expressed: That is to say, A large Roman P, together with to wear a the first Letter of the Name of the County, whereof such Poor is an Inhabi- Badge, &c. tant, cut either in red, or blue Cloth, as by the Overseer of the Poor it shall be directed and appointed; and, if any such poor Person shall neglect, or refuse to wear such Badge, or Mark, as aforesaid, and in Manner, as aforesaid, it shall and may be lawful for any one of the Trustees aforesaid, where any such Offence shall be committed, to punish every such Offender, for every such Offence, either by ordering of his, or her Relief, or usual Allowance, to be abridged, suspended, or withdrawn; or otherwise, by ordering such Offender to b. whipt, not exceeding Twenty Lashes, and kept to hard Labour for any Number of Days, not exceeding Twenty-one, as to the said Trustee, in his Discretion, it shall most seem meet; and, if any Overseer of the Poor, shall receive, into any Alms, and Work-House, or shall relieve any such Perfon, not having and wearing such Badge or Mark, as aforesaid, and be thereof convicted, upon the Oath of one or more credible Witness, or Witnesses, shall forfeit and pay the Sum of Five Pounds Current Money.

XXI. and be it further Enacted, That whotoever shall presume, either Persons selto set up a Booth, Stall, or other Convenience, for the selling of strong Liquors to the quors, on the Land purchased in any of the Counties aforesaid, for the Use Poor, on the Land purchaof an Alms, or Work-House, or shall commit any kind of Trespass thereon, sed for an or shall sell or dispose of any strong Liquor, or other Matter or Thing, what-Alms, and Work-House, foever, to any Poor, or other Person, entertained in such Alms, and Works forfeit iol. House, shall, for every such Offence, forfeit and pay the Sum of Ten Pounds Current Money.

XXII. And be it further Enacted, That all and every the Pains, Penalties, Penalties and and Forfeitures, herein before by this Act directed and inflicted, shall, and recoverable in may be recovered, in any Court of Record, within this Province, by A any Court of Record; one of Debt, founded on this Act, or Indictment, wherein no Essoin, Protection, Moiety to the or Wager of Law, or more than one Imparlance shall be allowed; any Thing Informer, the in this Act herein before contained, to the contrary thereof, in any wife, not-Use of the withstanding; one Moiety to the Informer, the other Moiety to the Use of the Work House, Alms, and Work-House, where such Recoveries shall be had and obtained; in &c. which Actions of Debt, it shall be sufficient for the Plaintiff, to alledge, that the Defendant or Defendants, are indebted to the Plaintiff, the Sums of Money, or Tobacco, by this Act directed and inflicted, whereby the Plaintiff's Action accrued to him, according to the Form of this Act of Assembly, without setting forth the Special Matter: Provided, a short Note, expressing the Cause of Action, be lodged in the Office, at the Time of issuing the Writ.

XXIII. And be it further Enacted, That all Sheriffs, Bailiffs, Constables, Officers to be and all other Officers, and Ministers of Justice, shall be aiding and affisting affist the Trusto the said Trustees for the Poor, in each of the said Counties, and to all tees in the Exfuch Officers, as shall be employed by them, as by this Act is directed, in the ecution of their Office. Execution and Performance of the said Service.

XXIV. And be it further Enacted, That if any Person or Persons, shall, at persons sued any Time or Times, be fued or profecuted for any Matter or Thing, by him for putting this Act in or them done, and executed in Pursuance and Execution of this Act, or of Execution, any Matter or Thing in this Act contained, such Person, or Persons, shall, may plead the and may plead the General Issue, and give this Act, and the Special Matter, &c. in Evidence, for his, or their Defence; and, if upon Trial, a Verdict shall pass for the Defendant, or Defendants, or if the Plaintiff, or Plaintiffs, shall become non-suited, or discontinue his, or their Suit, then, such Defendant,
