An ACT to oblige the several County Clerks to have with them, on their Office Days, the Four last Courts Dockets and Papers.

HEREAS, by the Act to enable the several and respective County Preamble. Clerks within this Province, to remove some of the County Records and Papers from the publick Offices, a Liberty is given to the said Clerks, to remove and take out their Four last Courts Dockets and Papers, next preceding the Time of such taking out, and the same to keep in their own Houses for their Convenience; under which Liberty it is found, that
