Authorities, to every Intent and Purpose, as the Visitors of the other County Schools within this Province; and shall have Succession in like Vacancy fill-Manner, so that every Vacancy be filled up with a Resident of that County ed up with a wherein the said Vacancy may happen, so that an equal Number of Visi- Resident of tors of each County may be kept up, any Law to the contrary thereof where it may notwithstanding.

IV. And be it surther Enasted, That of all Duties, Taxes, and Impo-All Duties, sitions, hereaster to be collected for the Use of the County Schools within to be paid to this Province, there shall be paid, by the Treasurers of the Western and the Visitors, Eastern Shores, to the Visitors aforesaid, or the major Part of them, or applied to the their Order, Two equal Dividends, by them to be applied and expended Use of the to and for the Use and Benefit of the said School, in the like Manner as School. the Dividends due to the other County Schools are by Law directed to be applied.

V. And, whereas, for defraying Part of the Expence and Charge of building the said School, sundry Inhabitants of the said Counties of Somer-Jet and Worcester have subscribed divers Sums of Money; and, whereas there is a considerable Sum of Money in the Hands of the Visitors of the said Schools, chosen under a former Act of Assembly, for the said Counties of Somerset and Worcester;

VI. Be it Enacted, That the Visitors constituted by this Act, or the The Visitors are Part of them shall and they are hereby amounted to receive M. major Part of them, shall, and they are hereby empowered to receive all by this Act, Monies by the said Persons subscribed, and all Monies in the Hands of the empowered Visitors chosen under the said former Law; and such Subscribers and Visi- to receive alltors are hereby directed to pay the Monies in their Hands, and their fore-scribed, or ral Subscriptions, to the Visitors appointed by this Act; and, in Case of which may Neglect or Refusal to pay the said Visitors or the major Port of the Neglect or Refusal to pay, the said Visitors, or the major Part of them, Hands of the may, and they are hereby authorised to sue for, recover, and receive the Visitors under a former fame.

VII. And be it suttber Enasted, That the said Visitors, or the major and also to Part of them, are hereby authorifed, empowered, and required to make Two Schools Sale, by Way of publick Vendue, of the Schools of the faid Two Counties and the Land of Somerfet and Worcester, with the Land thereto belonging, to the best thereto beand highest Ridder and convey the same in Fig. Simple to the Burnhaser. and highest Bidder, and convey the same, in Fee Simple, to the Purchaser or Purchasers, his or their Heirs and Assigns for ever; and the Money arifing by the Sale thereof, as well as from Subscriptions, shall be applied to the Use of the said School, any Law, Usage, or Custom, to the contrary notwithstanding.

## XIII.

An ACT to enable the Justices of Dorchester County Court to affess and levy, on the taxable Inhabitants of the said County, a Quantity of Tobacco, for the Purpose of building a Court-House.

HEREAS sundry of the Inhabitants of Dorchester County, by Preamble. their Petition to this General Assembly, have set forth, That the present Court-House of the said County is much out of Repair, and so small and inconvenient in every Respect, as to be unfit to transact the publick Business in: And have therefore humbly prayed that it may be Enacted;
