

C. H. A. P. III. Authority of the same, That all Causes, Pleas, Proceſs and Pleadings, now depending in, or returnable to the ſaid High Court of Appeals now ſitting, and which cannot otherwiſe ſo long continue, ſhall be, and are by Virtue of this Act, adjourned, and continued until the Third Friday in November next, and ſhall then be in the ſame State, Place and Condition, as they now are; any Law, Uſage or Cuſtom to the contrary notwithstanding.

An ACT empowering the Juſtices of Prince George's and Frederick Counties, to levy on the taxable Perſons of Prince George's Pariſh in ſaid Counties, the Sum of Ninety-fix Thouſand Pounds of Tobacco, for building a new Pariſh Church, at or near the Place where the old one now ſtands.

Preamble.

WHEREAS the Rector, Veſtrymen, Churchwardens and ſundry Pariſhioners of Prince George's Pariſh, in Prince George's and Frederick Counties, by their humble Petition to this General Aſſembly, repreſenting that their Pariſh Church is in a ruinous Situation and very much gone to Decay, ſo as to be quite unfit for any further Repairs, and evidently dangerous for the Miniſter and Congregation who attend Worſhip there, have prayed that an Act may paſs for the Aſſeſſment of Ninety-fix Thouſand Pounds of Tobacco on the taxable Inhabitants of the ſaid Pariſh, for building a new Pariſh Church.

II. Be it therefore enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Conſent of his Lordſhip's Council, and the Upper and Lower Houſes of Aſſembly, and the Authority of the ſame, That the Juſtices of Prince George's and Frederick Counties, for the Time being, ſhall be, and they are hereby empowered and required, on the Application of the Veſtry and Churchwardens of Prince George's Pariſh aforeſaid, for the major Part of them, to aſſeſs and levy on the taxable Inhabitants of the ſaid Pariſh, the aforeſaid Sum of Ninety-fix Thouſand Pounds of Tobacco, and the Salary of Five per Centum to the Sheriff for collecting the ſame, at Two equal Aſſeſſments, which ſaid Aſſeſſments ſhall be reſpectively made by the Juſtices aforeſaid, in Proportion to the taxable Inhabitants of the ſaid Pariſh, reſiding in their reſpective Counties; and the ſame, together with the Sheriff's Salary for Collection, ſhall be payable by the taxable Inhabitants of the ſaid Pariſh, and collected by the Sheriffs of ſaid Counties, in common Money, at the Rate of Twelve Shillings and Six pence per Hundred Pounds of Tobacco, and ſhall be by them reſpectively paid to the Veſtry and Churchwardens of the ſaid Pariſh for the Time being; who are hereby authorized and empowered to apply the ſame to the building a new Pariſh Church, at or near the Place where the old one now ſtands, and to no other Uſe or Purpoſe whatſoever.

The Juſtices of Prince-George's and Frederick Counties, on Application of the Veſtry, &c. of Prince George's Pariſh, to levy on the taxable Inhabitants of ſaid Pariſh 96,000 lb Tobacco, for building a new Pariſh Church.

A Supplementary Act to the Act entitled, An Act for the building a Pariſh Church in Queen Anne Pariſh, in Prince George's County.

Preamble, relating Part of a former Act.

WHEREAS by the Act entitled, An Act for the building a Pariſh Church in Queen Anne Pariſh, in Prince George's County, the Juſtices of the ſaid County were thereby required to levy upon the taxable Inhabitants of the ſaid Pariſh, a Quantity not exceeding One Hundred
