

Hundred and Fifty Thousand Pounds of Tobacco together with the Sheriff's Salary of Five Pounds of Tobacco per Centum for collecting the same, by Three equal Assessments; that is to say, One Third Part thereof at their November Court in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy, One Third Part thereof at their November Court in the Year One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy-one, and the remaining One Third Part thereof at their November Court in the Year One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy-two; but if appearing, that for the Want of timely Notice of the said Act, no Part of the above Sum of One Hundred and Fifty Thousand Pounds of Tobacco was levied by the Justices aforesaid at their November Court in the Year Seventeen Hundred and Seventy.

II. Be it therefore enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That the Justices of Prince George's County shall and may, and they are hereby required to levy on the taxable Inhabitants of Queen Anne Parish aforesaid, at their November Court which shall be in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy-three, so much of the said One Hundred and Fifty Thousand Pounds of Tobacco, and Salary for Collection, as was directed and intended to have been levied at their November Court in the Year One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy, to be collected, paid and applied as by the above Act expressed and declared, any Thing therein contained to the contrary notwithstanding.

C H A P. V.

An ACT continuing an Act, entitled, *An Act to establish a Market at the Market-House, in Chester-Town, in Kent County, and for the Regulation of the said Market.*

BE it enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That an Act of Assembly of this Province, entitled, *An Act to establish a Market at the Market-House, in Chester-Town, in Kent County, and for the Regulation of the said Market*, made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis the Seventeenth Day of March One Thousand Seven Hundred and Sixty-two, be, and is hereby continued in full Force, from and after the End of this present Session of Assembly, for and during the Term of Three Years, and to the End of the next Session of Assembly which shall happen after the End of the said Three Years.

C H A P. VI.

An ACT continuing an Act, entitled, *An Act for the Preservation of the Breed of Fish.*

BE it enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That an Act of Assembly of this Province, entitled, *An Act for the Preservation of the Breed of Fish*, made at a Session of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis, on Tuesday the Twenty-fourth Day of May Seventeen Hundred and Sixty-eight, be, and is hereby continued, and shall remain and be in full Force for and during the Term of Three Years, and to the End
