The Church IV. C H A P. X.

An ACT to empower the Justices of Worcester County to levy on the taxable Inhabitants of All-Hullows Parish, in said County, the Quantity of Thirty-two Thousand Pounds of Tobacco, for the Uses therein mentioned.

Preamble.

HIREAS the Rector, Vestrymen, Churchwardens, and sundry of the Inhabitants of All-Hallows Parish, in Worcester County, have, by their humble Petition to this present General Assembly, set forth, That the Church, situate at Snow-Hill-Town, being the only Place in said Parish whereat divine Service is performed, is so distant from the exterior Parts of said Parish, that a great Number of the Inhabitants have it not in their Power to attend said Church, at Snow-Hill; and, forasmuch, as the said Inhabitants are desirous of having a Chapel of Ease erected, in such Part of the said Parish, where they may partake of the Advantage of attending divine Service, and hearing a Sermon once in every Three Weeks, and have prayed, that an Act may pass,
