

**C. H. A. P. XVII.** Tobacco, together with the Sheriff's Salary of Five per Centum for Collection; which said Quantity of Tobacco, so to be assessed and levied, shall be collected by the Sheriff of the said County, from the several taxable Inhabitants of the said County, in the same Manner as other Publick and County Levies are by Law collected; and the said Tobacco when collected, shall be paid by such Sheriff to the said Commissioners or the major Part of them, or their Order, for the Use and Purpose by the said Act intended; and the Inhabitants of the said County may pay and discharge the said Tobacco, so to be levied, in Money, in the same Manner as they are now, or shall hereafter be enabled to pay and discharge the Publick or County Levy.

Justices to agree for a Place to hold County Courts, &c.

**VI.** And be it further enacted, That after the old Court-House aforesaid shall be pulled down, the Justices of the said County shall and may contract and agree for a convenient Place within the said Town of Cambridge, to hold the Courts of the said County, and the said Courts shall be held at such Place until the new Court-House shall be built, completed and finished, and the Charge and Expence of holding the Courts at such Place shall be defrayed by the said County, and assessed with the Publick and County Levy.

**C. H. A. P. XVII.** An Act to empower Frank Leake and George Diggers Administrators of the last Will of the late Charles to their Executors of Administration annexed, to sell a Lot of Ground of the late Charles, situate and being in the Town of Upper Marlborough in Prince George's County aforesaid for the Payment of the Debts of the said Charles Diggers. **C. H. A. P. XVIII.** An additional Supplementary Act to the Act, entitled, An Act for the Relief of the Poor within the several Counties therein mentioned.

Preamble, reciting Part of a former Act.

**W**HEREAS by the Act, entitled, A Supplementary Act to the Act, entitled, An Act for the Relief of the Poor within the several Counties therein mentioned, that the Justices of Frederick County Court, for the Time being, were thereby required and empowered, upon the Application of the Trustees of the Poor, or the major Part of them, to assess and levy on the taxable Inhabitants of the said County, a Quantity not exceeding Ten Pounds of Tobacco by the Poll, in the Years Seventeen Hundred and Seventy, and Seventeen Hundred and Seventy-one, together with the Sheriff's Salary of Five per Cent. for Collection; but it appearing that for the Want of timely Notice of the said Act, no Part of the above Assessments as by the said Act required, was levied by the Justices of said County, at their November Court in the Year Seventeen Hundred and Seventy.

**II.** Be it therefore enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That the Justices of Frederick County shall and may, and they are hereby required, to levy on the taxable Inhabitants of the said County, at their November Court in this present Year, a Quantity not exceeding Twenty Pounds of Tobacco by the Poll, together with the Sheriff's Salary of Five
