III. And be it further enacted, That every Commissioner of the said. Town, who shall vote for any of the said Officers, shall take the following Oath, before he shall be entitled to vote for the Nomination and Appointment of all or any of the Officers aforementioned, to wit. I A.B. do The Oath. jwear, that I will faithfully, honestly and impartially, nominate and appoint such Person or Persons, to be Inspector of Flour within the said Town of Baltimore and at Fell's-Point, and also such Measurers of Grain, Salt and Elax-seed, Gullers or Garblers and Counters of Staves, Heading and Shingles, Weighers of Hay and Wood Corders within the Town of Baltimore and Fell's-Point, as I think in my Judgment and Conscience, is or are sit and capable to execute the said Offices respectively.

IV. And be it further enaited, That in Case of the Death of any or in Case of either of the said Officers so nominated and appointed, or the Resusal or Susal of Either Inability of them, or either of them, to act, the said Commissioners, or of said Offithe major Part of them, shall, as soon as conveniently may be thereafter, cers, Commeet together and nominate and appoint one other such Person as afore—appoint anotaid, in the Stead and Place of any Person so dying, resusing or becoming the Person incapable to act, for the Residue of the Year then to come; and if the in his Stead; incapable to act, for the Residue of the Year then to come; and if the in his Stead; and Commissioners shall neglect and omit to nominate and appoint, all, or any of the said respective Officers, then, and in such Case, the Governor or Commander in Chief of this Province, for the Time being, may, by and on Ne-Commander in Chief of this Province, for the Time being, may, by and on Ne-Officers, who shall be qualified agreeable to the Directions of this Act, minate. VI. And he it further enacted. That if any Bolter shall put a false or Bolters putwrong Tare on any Cask of Flour, more than one Pound Weight to the Tare on any Disidvantage of the Purchaser, such Bolter shall forfeit and pay, for every Cask of Disidvantage of the Purchaser, such Bolter shall forfeit and pay, for every Cask of such Cask wrongfully or falsely tared as aforesaid, the Sum of Ten Shil-Flour, to forseit the sum of the Buyer, shall uncase or unpack any such Cask of Flour, in Request of the Buyer, shall uncase or unpack any such Casks, be found to Order to try the Tare thereof; and if the said Cask or Casks, be found to be tared more than one Pound less than the true Weight, the Bolter thereof shall pay the Charge and Expence of Unpacking or Uncasing, and Repacking or Recasing, over and above the Sum of Ten Shilling's current Money, for each Cask as aforesaid; but if the Weight of the same is not more than one Pound less than the Tare thereon marked, then the Inmore than one Pound less than the Tare thereon marked, then the Infector or Purchaser, at whose Request such Trial be made, shall pay the Costs of Unpacking or Uncasing, and Repacking or Recasing.
