and Flax-seed, and Hay-Weighers, and each of them, so as aforesaid to be appointed, shall, and they and each of them are hereby required, on his or their Appointment, and before his or their executing the said Office, to make Oath (or Affirmation if a Quaker) before a Justice of the Peace, Oath of That they and each of them, when required, will well and truly, accorded, ding to the best of his or their Skill and Knowledge, measure all Grain, Salt and Flax-seed, and weigh all Hay, without any Fear, Favour, Affection, Malice or Partiality whatever, to the Buyer or Seller; and that they, and each of them, will not, willingly or wittingly, charge, ask, take, receive, exact or demand, any other or larger Fees or Rates, for doing his or their Duty, in his or their Office, than is mentioned and directed by this Act.

XXIV. and, whereas the preventing Frauds and Abuses, in culting and counting Staves, Heading and Shingles, large Quantities of which are exported, will tend to advance the Credit of the same at foreign Markets, and promote the Trade and Commerce of the said Town of Baltimore;

XXV. Be it therefore enacted, That from and after the First Day of Staves, Head-December next, all Staves, Heading and Shingles, brought to, and offered shingles, to for Sale within the said North-West Branch of Patapseo, shall be submit—be examined, ted to the Examination of the Officer so as aforesaid to be appointed for &c. by an that Purpose; and, if the said Officer shall find the same sound, and sit appointed for Exportation, he shall count, cull and garble the same, in a just and impartial Manner between the Buyer and Seller; for which Trouble, he, the said Officer, shall receive and have, as follows, to wit, for every customary Thousand of Pipe Staves, Two Shillings current Money; for His Allowevery customary Thousand of Hogshead Staves, or Hogshead Heading, One Shilling and Eight-pence current Money; and for every customary Thousand of Barrel Staves; One Shilling current Money; and for every Thousand Shingles, Six-pence current Money; the One Half thereof to be paid by the Buyer, the other Half by the Seller.

XXVI. Provided always, and he it further enacted.
