and levied, shall be collected by the Sheriff of the said County, from the C.H.A.P. several taxable Persons who shall reside within the said County, in the same Manner as other Publick and County Levies are by Law collected; to be applied and the said Tobacco when so as aforesaid collected, shall be paid by towards finishing and such Sheriff to the Commissioners hereafter named, or the major Part of completing them, or their Order or Orders, who are hereby authorised and required the Prison to receive and apply the same to the Uses and Purposes following, that is House, and Courts to say, to finish and compleat the said Prison and Court-House.

III. Provided nevertheless, That if the said Quantity of Tobacco when Provision made collected, should be more than sufficient for the Purposes aforesaid, then, and in such Case, the Overplus shall be paid into the Hands of the Justices of the said County, and applied to pay and discharge the Publick and County Levy of the said County.

IV. And be it further enacted, That Robert Alexander, William Smith, John Commissioners appointed Maule and Andrew Buchanan, be, and are hereby appointed Commissioners to execute and perform the Trust reposed in them and required by this Act, and they are hereby empowered to treat and agree with Undertakers or Workmen, to finish and compleat the said Court-House and Prison.

V. Provided always, and be it enacted, That it shall and may be law, Provisa. ful for the several and respective Inhabitants of the said County, to pay and discharge the said Quantity of Tobacco, so as aforesaid, to be assessed and levied, in Money, at the Rate of Ten Shillings current Money per Hundred Pounds of Tobacco, to be paid into the hands of the Commissioners appointed to execute and perform the Trust reposed in them and required by this Act.

An Act to empower Elizabeth Williams, Administratrix of George Williams, with the Will annexed, to make and execute the Conveyances therein mentioned. (A Private Act.)

C H A . P . XXX.

An Act to empower Jane Ridgely, Executrix of Nicholas Greenberry Ridgely, late of Anne-Arundel County, deceased, to convey the Land therin mentioned. (A Private Act.)

C H A . P . No. XXXI.

An Additional Supplementary Act to the Act, entitled, *An Act for the Establishment of Religious Worship in this Province according to the Church of England, and for the Maintenance of Ministers.*

BE it enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, &c. and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That Ministers to every Minister, who shall be presented, inducted or appointed, to any Church Living or Benefice, within this Province, shall, within Four Months thereafter, take the several Oaths appointed by Law to be taken to the Government, subscribe the Oath of Abjuration and repeat and subscribe the Test, in the Provincial Court, or in the County Court of the County in which his Living or Benefice shall be; and then also, in the same Court, take the following Oath, to wit, I A. B. do swear, that I have made no Suriunal Contract, Payment, or Promise, directly or indirectly,
