LXXXVI. And be it enafted, That in all Cases under the late In-Justices torespection Law, where the Owners or Proprietors of Warehouses have kents till given the same up to be repaired or rebuilt at the Expence of the County, the Money and the Rents already received have not reimburfed the Monies advanced advanced be in rebuilding or repairing such Warehouses, it shall and may be lawful for the Justices of said Counties, and they are hereby authorized and required to receive the Rents of all such Warehouses from the Inspector or Inspectors, under the present Act, until the whole Money advanced, as aforesaid, shall be repaid, any Thing herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding.

LXXXVII.
